



Is dormitory life alive?

LEASE AGREEMENT D59, 1972.

"The lease agreement begins on March 1st, 1972..."

"The lease amounts to DKK 450 per month, to be paid on the first day of each month..."

"The tenant is obligated to participate in the turn based telephone central operations..."

"Stamp for the lease agreement, as well as expenses for name tag and bedbug certificate are paid by the tenant..."

Actually, there is not a big difference between the rules of 2014 and Nybrogård Kollegiet's first lease agreement, which was found behind a cabinet and now decorates the superintendent's office.

The document, which was written for Daniel Japha D59 in 1972, can shed some light on how Nybrogård Kollegiet was established, and why it has become what it is today. We spoke to The dormitory's trusty superintendent, Lars Kaj.

KUA was planned to be placed at Radiomarken, which was the reason for building Nybrogård Kollegiet. The probability that Daniel Japha studied at KUA is very small. And as we know, most of the residents at Nybrogård now study at DTU.

A, B, C, D buildings were first ready. However, some of the tenants received a discount towards their lease because of large amounts of mud outside the doorways.

KUA never came, but the residents did, and there has never been an

empty room at the dormitory since.

Why? If you ask the dormitory's superintendent, Lars Kaj, there is no doubt "The dormitory has the best location in the country!"

KAB administers ca. 50,000 residences in the Greater Copenhagen Area. Among those, is Nybrogård Kollegiet. Lars Kaj has worked at the dormitory for 18 years. "When I participate in meetings with KAB, I always hear that we have the sweetest residents in the world", Lars Kaj recounts. Shut-in cats, hamster farms and microwave ovens in the rooms are small potatoes compared to what other places have to put up with.

Invitation for Cake Festival on March 29th. The requested funds are not currently necessary, but they will apply for DKK 500 at the next meeting, to cover unexpected expenses.

The chairman has approved that the Exercise Room has purchased equipment on auction for ~ DKK 19,000.

The chairman has approved KælderCaféen's opening on New Year's Eve after an e-mail questionnaire.

The Network Group: Is currently installing faster internet and eliminating bottlenecks for each hallway.

7) Review of the minutes of the last board meeting or agenda for the next one

George (member from DTU) has calculated that we have shown a decrease in heating and electricity spending after the renovation in 2009/10.

8) Inward correspondence

a) Digital TV - NOW - Mikkel J21

Required deadline regarding digital channels

Lars Kaj: It costs DKK 15,000 in equipment, per channel that needs to be upgraded.

Jakob: Use the saved income from the cell phone antenna to pay for the expansion.

Alexander: Access to the TV channel poll was a problem for many because of missing passwords for the forum, etc. The Network Group responds: K-Net is putting a system in place that makes it possible to reset your NYK password without contacting the Network Group. Timeline unknown.

Majbritt: The composition of the economy must be visible during this change.

Line: The economy should be investigated before the next meeting and not after/during the TV channel poll.

Jakob will look into it before next meeting.

b) NybroTidende requests access to the secretariat - Jakob R52

It would ease our printing task if we had direct access to the secretariat and the computers down there. So far, we have had access only because Jakob is on the board, but when he moves, we would like to retain access. We request permission to give 1 person a key and login to the computer in the secretariat.

c) New kitchen exhaust system - Sofie E. Holsten H53

In my kitchen, the current exhaust system is not working at all. It is just an open hole, and every time we cook, the kitchen quickly becomes congested and smelly. I hope you will discuss the possibility of installing new exhaust systems in the kitchens.

The item is discarded because the person is not present. Remember that an item will not be discussed unless the responsible person is present.

In this case, the issue is a regular operations incident, since the exhaust in GH had completely stopped working.

The board is looking at a new exhaust system, but it has previously been

rejected because of the very high price.

d) Active-party for all (voluntary) in the NYK association - Thomas C05

An 'active-party' is proposed for all the active residents of the dormitory. If this is approved, a decision regarding whether the paid NYK staff also should be invited (NybroTidende, Network Group, etc.), or if only the volunteers under NYK's association should be included, e.g. chairmen for the various clubs, residents' council representatives, etc.

The Cake Committee would very much like an invitation, since they felt cheated last year.

The Exercise Room has been fortunate enough to find some good, inexpensive machines being sold at a foreclosure auction. Unfortunately, their bank account is completely empty. So they must apply for funds to cover the price of the machines. Their disposable amount for the year has also been spent.

They are applying for funding for these expenses.

The Exercise Room is applying for the full amount, out of which they will pay DKK 10,000 from their disposable amount. That way, they can freely use next year's disposable amount when the time comes.

KælderCaféen's financial report 2013:

A large renovation and many closed nights have given a smaller income than budgeted.

This amount will be used to pay bills in the beginning of 2014.

The residents' council would like an appendix to be sent out with the notice. An appendix will be presented at the next meeting.

Better explanations of items are necessary, in order to make it easier to discuss in the kitchens. Remember to give each item a title and a short summary—then it is possible to add 'long' appendices.



The Canoe Club



After a tough season in 2013, we are



A) Lock on the door – ST backdoor

A lock on the backdoor to ST is proposed, so only residents of the block can enter through the door. There are constantly problems with residents being woken up by guests of Kælders-Caféen walking back to their kitchens, talking and making noise. Residents are being kept awake between 3:00 and 4:00 Friday night as well as on those Saturdays when Kælders-Caféen is open or hired.

B) ST-odd proposes to move the volleyball net to the field in front of either the ST or NO kitchens.

It causes great discomfort for the residents whose windows face the volleyball field. In the summer, there is a lot of noise from the field and some residents are forced to keep their windows closed, to avoid dam-

age to the window mechanisms from impacts with the ball and to avoid the ball being hit into their rooms. This is not a sustainable situation. There is also often loud music from the field, as well as the occasional bright lighting to accommodate late night games. It is very disturbing and it should be possible to move the volleyball field to a different location where it will not inconvenience residents.

C) New chairman of the Garden Group

The Garden Group would like to announce that a new chairman has been chosen on January 28th. The previous chairman is leaving the dormitory soon, and after a vote, the responsibility has been passed to Miia Ebbesen from H-6.

D) Administration of the Cinema Club

Nikolaj would like to volunteer for the task of administering the Cinema Club. He has attempted to become a member himself, but it is seemingly much too difficult and longwinded. One possible reason could be that the underlying processes are poorly constructed or adjusted. If that is the case, he hopes to be able to solve it in cooperation with the chairmen and possibly the Network Group. He has invited the two chairmen of the club to join the residents' council meeting, so they can shed some light on the situation. Lastly, Nikolaj would like the residents' council to vote in regards to whether he should undertake the administration of the Cinema Club.

Chili on my mind!



Emil is studying Biology at KU and has cultivated chili in his windowsill for over 10 years.

We at NybroTidende could not resist printing this article. That is why we have given the word to our dormitory's Chili Emil in this edition of *Enjoy the Food*, where he will tell us about cultivating chili in your windowsill.

The time for sowing chili seeds is NOW, so read on and get to it!

Sow indoors in March

It is best to sow by the end of February or beginning of March. If you do, make sure they get 25-30 Celcius temperatures and plenty of water. Putting the seeds in a plastic bag with moist coffee filters/paper towels and hanging the bag over a heater works well. Check on them every day. When they start to show a small root sprouting, place them in a pot in the windowsill, ca. 1cm below the surface. Careful, the root will break easily, and that will end your chili's life.

You will need:

Plastic pots with holes in the bottom. There is no upper limit regarding their size, but small pots need a lot of care.

Something to place the pots in, to avoid water spilling everywhere.

Buy soil (NOT potting or top soil)

Fertilizer

Walkthrough:

Place the plant in the windowsill. A window towards north (towards Lyngby Lake) is too dark, and closing the curtains during the day will not work either.

Watering: When the pot is light in weight, the plant has evaporated most of the water, and it is time to add more. Pour water into the saucer below the pot and remove the water that is not soaked up into the pot after 15 minutes. The bigger the pot, the more water it will be able to hold, and therefore it will require less frequent watering.



King winter is releasing his grip and spring is starting to show its first signs. And what is greater than watching the trees and flowers bloom? I advise you to bring some of the life spirit and optimism inside. To watch something grow and develop is very life confirming and if you want a potted plant in your room, you might as well make it one that you can eat from. Cultivating vegetables and following the seasons' effects on them is an easy way to get closer to nature and the flow of the seasons.

I have been cultivating chilis for many years, and the reason it caught on to begin with, is that it is not very difficult. Chilis have been getting a lot of media attention during the past year (read: Chili Klaus). It seems like people are discovering that there are other kinds than the long red one from Netto. And there are plenty of others. A regular guess is that there are over 2,000 kinds. That is the reason I have not stopped yet. There is always a new color, taste or shape. Another advantage is that a single plant can produce enough for a whole year's supply, and the plant thrives in a windowsill.
