

Complaints Committee seeks new employees!

Nybrogård Kollegiet's Complaints Committee is seeking new employees, since several of the previous employees have left the dormitory. At the moment, 2 positions are available - both of which are going to be filled during this round. If you are hired, you can expect to start together with another new employee.

If you send an application, you will receive a confirmation from the board, so you know your application has been received. Then you will be called down to a meeting in the GH-basement where both the board's resident members and the Complaints Committee current employees will be present.

What does the job entail?

Handling complaints is the primary job function, but besides that, it is also the responsibility of the Complaints Committee to do hallway rounds. A hallway round is a

walk around the dormitory, which is done to ensure that the fire regulations are being followed.

What are the necessary qualifications?

The ability to make yourself understood, a flair for mediation and an understanding of the importance of confidentiality in the tasks are qualities which are expected. Previous experience is not required, but obviously an advantage.

What are the hours like?

You should be able to take one shift each week. The Complaints Committee is open Tuesdays from 19:30-20:00, which constitute fixed working hours. On average you will be working around 1 hour per week, but in busy periods, it will be more than that. Of course, you can take leave for short periods

for exams or vacation as long as it is coordinated with the other employees in the Complaints Committee.

Other info:

The salary is DKK 120 per hour and you will be thoroughly trained by the other employees.



Second hand markets - saving tips!

Most people know that money can be saved when shopping second hand, but HOW much can you save? WHAT to buy and what not to buy? WHICH kinds of things can you sell again? - The answers are all here!

How much?

The amount of saved money is always dependent on the specific item, so it is not possible to define this exactly. But we can mention some (rough) figures relating to certain types of merchandise.

A few examples:

Electronics

The most traded category of merchandise on the second hand markets (between young people), besides clothing, would probably be electronics. Phones, computers and gaming consoles are traded right and left! Here are a few examples from the current marketplace:

PlayStation 3 with various accessories:

DKK 600-800. New: DKK 1,500 no games

iPhone 5s 16GB:

DKK 3,000-3,500. New: DKK 4,899 (El-Giganten)

DVD films 24-36 titles:

DKK 200. New films: DKK 150-200 per title

When shopping PS3, a lot can be saved, since games and an extra controller are often included.

Sports equipment

It is possible to find very cheap merchandise compared to their 'new price'. But be careful! Watch out for wear and tear on any sports equipment you buy. So, what does sports equipment entail? It can be anything from football boots to trampolines and skis.

Examples:

A pair of skis with sticks and a bag:

DKK 400. New: DKK 2,000 (the editor took this offer off the market)

A pair of football boots:

It varies, but some are available for DKK 80, while others cost DKK 300. Be aware whether it is the top model or the cheap knock-off.

A spinning bike for the dormitory room:

DKK 500. New: DKK 3-4,000

Thousands of kroner in savings!

What not to buy?

What should you stay away from when trying to save money? You can practically buy anything, as long as it is not fenced, but there are some things that are not as profitable to buy second hand.

Sofas

For some reason, sofas do not lose much value, despite them being one of the most worn pieces of furniture available. It is possible to find good quality sofas at low prices,



but you will have to look more thoroughly than when looking for e.g. electronics.

Never buy a sofa that you have only seen pictures of. Check it out in person and always ask how long it has been used and why it is being sold.

Bicycles



You can find plenty of high quality bicycles on e.g. DBA. BUT if you are looking for a bicycle for DKK 1,000-1,400, you will only find old men's bicycles or bicycles with a lot of scratches/wear. You should rather buy a new bicycle and sell it when you are done using it for not too much less than you paid for it.

What to sell?

Instead of using things, it can also be nice to SELL them and earn a little money for the food budget. Just as you can buy anything, you can practically sell anything as well. However, some things are more sellable than others, and another thing to keep in

mind: WHERE should you sell your things?

Things that typically retains its sellability especially include brand name merchandise. That is because these things are often considered to be long lasting. These are found in all categories of merchandise. As long as the product is of a brand name, and it is not too worn, it can be sold at a good price.

So, where can you sell your things?

DBS.dk is probably the most commonly known, but there are also other sites that can be recommended for certain categories!



The largest marketplace in Denmark for used clothing is definitely Trendsales.dk's 'bazar' department, where users sell and buy clothing. Here is your chance to find a new shirt or a dress for the next party at small prices.

Retro furniture/paintings/antiquities

Lauritz.com/QXL

It is important to note that when you sell at auction, you are taking a risk. These websites are not something I would really recommend, but the idea behind it is solid.

If you have a retro table, a pretty painting or a clock you inherited, then you can get an auction house to appraise it for FREE. If it is worth anything and you need some cash, then lauritz.com is a possibility. If it is not worth much, but you would still like to sell it at auction, then QXL.dk is an auction site for items of lesser value.



A Million Ways to Die in the West – Review

A film peppered with fun, violence, sex, contemporary curses, past problems and loads of alcohol! – a good recipe for a modern interpretation of a western.

What surprised me most when I watched the film *A Million Ways to Die in the West*, was not the countless deaths or the number of great actors, but the use of language! The film is set in the 1890's, and I doubt they used the word 'fuck' as much then as they do in this film! There are many references to contemporary behavior, which makes the film a tad more interesting. "You really shouldn't drink and horse", "Let's get fucked up", "I think he want's anal", "Holy shit!", "Shut the fuck up", "God this fucking fair!" – quotes from the film. Judge for yourself, whether they belong in the 1890's?

Seth Mcfarlane (better known as the creator of *Family Guy*, the voice of Ted, and more) is in the lead role in this spot-on-dormitory-



kitchen-humor-film, filled with big names such as: Charlize Theron (from the film "Reindeer Games"), Liam Nesson, Neil Pa-

trick Harris and more..

The humor is not for everyone, but it hit the spot for me with its ironic angle on life in the west, as well as the way its story is executed. The title is a little confusing before you have watched the film, but I can say that it really is a film that shows how many different and strange ways it is possible to die in the west.

While the story develops, and excitement surpasses humor, the fun stops for me, since the plot is not Oscar-nomination material. A mixed feeling by the end, since I was really only waiting for the film to end.
