Bike Cleanup

Is the area in front of your block entrance also flooded with bicycles?

This is the situation in most areas of the dormitory. A long time has passed since the last bicycle cleanup. In fact, it has been over two years since October 14th, 2012. Considering this, it should not be a surprise that the dormitory is filled with unused bicycles.

At the last residents' council meeting, a new bicycle cleanup event was requested. The Environmental Group were asked to organize it. Although the Environmental Group would love to do so, they would appreciate any help they can get with the task.

The bicycle cleanup is a joint responsibility here at the dormitory, but planning it does not require everyone's participation. Exactly the planning, however, is often the achille's heel - it is a big task, right?

Good news of the day: NO, it is actually not a big task. Lars Kaj has plenty of

experience with these cleanups, which means he is ready to offer much guidance and help. He will order the items necessary on the day of the cleanup - trash-pickers, trash bags, colored zip ties, manila tags and so on. The biggest task is reaching an agreement with the police.

The law requires bicycle cleanup organizers to report the cleanup event 3 months in advance and also to produce an agreement with the police that they will pick up the bicycles on the following weekday. The cleanup should therefore be executed on a Sunday, so the bicycles can be picked up on the following Monday. Finding the number and making an agreement with the police is usually the biggest challenge.

Casanova: A concept: A real Casanova - an admirer of women.



A suggestion is made to ban topless exposure in the Exercise Room. This is to ensure that consideration is shown towards other residents' modesty. Several have expressed that they find it repulsive. A vote has shown that the majority vote 'no' to topless exposure. This has not been respected. The regulations' sections 3 item 3 states that residents are subject to adhere to any restrictions of freedom necessary to preserve the community of all residents at the dormitory.

- The chairman put up an anonymous vote which 60 people saw and 80 responded to. It was dismissed. The rather surprising number of voters could be explained by people forwarding it to like minded friends. The mere possibility of foul play meant that the vote was dismissed. There has previously been a clear majority for not making any rules. The residents' council feels that the club should handle this themselves. The chairman is neutral.

k) Financial report from KælderCaféen (D):

- Representative of KælderCaféen KælderCaféen's financial report will be presented. Appendix will follow.

- The report has been presented and understood. KælderCaféen are reminded to present their financial report at the first meeting after each quarter, and that KælderCaféen must present the report themselves.

l) Decision regarding sale of kegs for the resident council's draft beer system (D):

- Representative of KælderCaféen A member of the bar team is willing to handle administration of the draft beer system, but KælderCaféen will not be responsible for purchasing kegs for it. We will work on a way to give the residents the option of purchasing a keg that they can then drink within an evening/weekend inside KælderCaféen.

This will reduce disturbances for other residents from parties in kitchens. The board does not feel they have been treated with a propoer level of respect in this discussion.

m) Changing the large TV package (D):

The full package can be seen in appendix 5.

There was a mistake in the original count. This has been corrected.

- A concern was raised regarding another children's channel, since there are already 2 free children's channels.

- If people opt out of the large package, the price for everyone else might become higher.

- It is more difficult to stream the channels we have removed, than those we have added.

Nikolaj will say more when he has heard from Flemming (responsible at KAB).

n) Attaining a greater diversity within hallways (D) (V):

- Rasmus Lau

There is a tendency to see certain groups appear in specific hallways/kitchens. A suggestion has previously been made to eliminate this in order to ensure functional, open hallway-living experiences for all residents. A limit on the occurrence of the same foreigners/educational fields and such is a suggestion.

Another suggestion could be to limit Dorte's freedom to assign new residents to specific hallways/rooms.

A discussion about what can be done is suggested, and whether certain initiatives can be started and/or forwarded to the board.

- There will always be people moving in and out of the dormitory. Regulating this will not necessarily have a positive effect.

- There does not seem to be a pre-

valent problem, so the item is dismissed with permission from the correspondent.

p) Closing KældersCaféen because of lack of financial report (D) (V):

The item is dropped if KældersCaféen presents a financial report at the meeting and the appendix is sent out in time. KældersCaféen has not presented their financial reports to the residents' council at the required times as specified in the rules (e.g. at the September meeting). At the last meeting, the agreed presentation was not made. The financial report was also delayed a month.

BEER PONG

Most of us have probably become acquainted with the party game Beer Pong!?!

If not, then you have really been missing out! Metroexpress wrote on news from the world of Beer Pong on October 22nd. We will pick up the topic and inform future players.

BEER PONG League

Foosball leagues already exist. The foosball table creates a competitive phenomenon in the city, which sometimes makes it difficult for us 'normal' foosball enthusiasts to get a goal in. Beer Pong has arrived in Denmark from the USA and has become a sensation in a number of Friday bars and dormitory kitchens already. Now, there is also a Beer Pong League. 23 year old Jacob Vestlev started Denmarks first Beer Pong League on November 23rd.

"I want to sportify the game, so people play it to become better at it - not because of the alcohol. At some point there may not even be beer in the cups."

Let us hope this does not result in Beer Pong becoming the new night time sport activity, but instead that it stays at a level low enough that we poor ball-retards can still have a chance.

Beer Pong rules

Beer Pong requires 1 or 2 tennis balls, about 22 plastic cups, a table, a healthy serving of beer or other alcohol and a smidge of ball control.

The cups are filled with beer. Usually, 10 cups are placed for each team. A good rule of thumb is that one beer is enough for three cups. The cups are placed symmetrically and a cup of water is placed close at hand to rinse the ball in.

The starting team is chosen by drawing lots, rock paper scissors or any other means. There is one ball for each team, They are either thrown at the same time or by turn.

While throwing, you must throw overhand, and you elbow must not cross over the edge of the table. If this rule is broken, the throw is invalid. Others throw by bouncing the ball on the table.

If the opponent puts the ball in a cup on your side, the team must drink the contents of that cup. Empty cups are removed from play. The turn changes until one of the teams have lost all of their cups. The loser must then drink all of the winners' cups, while the winners can call themselves
