The Football Season Begins!

Spring is finally upon us, which means that the teams are getting ready for a new season. The two teams have already begun, but their usual training grounds have only just gotten available.

For those who have not been introduced to the dormitory's football teams, here comes a short introduction. The dorm has two football teams: A male team (11 on field) and a female team (7 on field). The female team is run together with the P. O. Pedersens dormitory. Both teams play in the Copenhagen Dormitory Football tournament (Kollegiefodbold.dk).

Entry in the dormitory football tournament is paid by the residents' council, making it free for you to join any of our teams. It is required to bring your own equipment.

The tournament has two divisions, for both teams. The men are placed in 2nd division, where they are looking forward to 14 tournament matches for this season, and at least one cup match, which will be against the arch enemy P.O.P

The women are placed in 1st division, where they are looking forward to 10 tournament matches with a minimum of one cup match against Egmont.

The teams will be training on the football fields at the Engelsborg halls. As seen on the map, a short bike ride can get you to the football fields, simply turn left when you reach the Netto, and you will see it on your right. The men's team train every Monday and Wednesday from 6 to 8 pm.



The women's team train every Tuesday and Thursday from 6 to 8 pm.

A Colourful Dormitory

Spring is upon us and summer is just around the corner. Yet it is only a few of us who own one of the attractive gardens that lie along Lyngby Lake. So how do you get started when you have no experience with plants?

Shared areas

Nybro Tidende is here to guide you. We've been to Alderhvile plant school to get advice and guidance on what us with-

will grow on the terrace. Herbs can survive being planted in a pot, but they will not grow. The reason for this, is that herbs need sunlight to have flavour, which makes our kitchen terraces unsuitable for herb plants. A solution could be to plant the herbs in pots, which can be moved to the area of the terrace that is receiving sunlight.

you need to have them "hanging" on the edge of the terrace, so that it receives as much sunlight as possible. Recommended flowers are: Flittiglise, Tagetes og Is pelargonier .

out gardens can plant at the shared areas. The shared areas of a kitchen are; the terrace outside the kitchen and the rooftop terrace. Two areas with very different climates when it comes to the amount of sun, wind and heat This of course, results in very different possibilities for planting. This month, were concentrating on the kitchen terrace. Here, you'll find shelter from wind, but the amount of minutes of sun that reach the terrace can be counted on one hand.

Edibles

As students, we have great interest in activities that can save us money while leaving us with a full stomach. This is why we have chosen to look at what can grow in these areas, and more importantly, that, which is also edible. The answer, is very disappointing. No herbs or vegetables

Things that climb

Now that our kitchen terraces have been deemed unsuitable for herbs, they can be used for decorative plants. Clematis will thrive along the concrete walls. The reason for choosing Clematis and not another plant that "crawls", is that Clematis doesn't grow into the wall, and therefore only requires some sort of wall mount to crawl along - Just the task for an engineer student.

Another type of plant that can be planted in pots or raised beds, while thriving in the shade, is the perennial shade plant. Perennials are one time investments. They are easy to look after, and can be incredibly decorative.

Flower boxes

On the 1st floor kitchens, it is possible to have flower boxes, just remember that


Gigolo: A word commonly especially used about men who receive payment for dancing with women

Booking




More activity will mean a greater need for arranging introductory courses and a greater need for repairs. Some initiatives are needed and Michaels says that this is where

3D printer in your dorm room?



3D printing has exploded this past year, and now it's possible for us ordinary people to use it at home!

Firstly: what is a 3D-printer? It's a machine that can print a three dimensional sculpture. They can, for example, make a dice or something more complex. How does it work? A conventional 3D printer uses a thin plastic thread, which it heats up and spews out. It uses this to draw, like drawing on paper with a pen, to make the sculpture, layer by layer. Other types of 3D printers exist, but are not covered in this article.

What can I print?

This is where your imagination is the only limitation. Examples for the dorm room could be a special holder for your cables, small figurines, a nameplate for your door etc. You can also go to thingiverse.com, where users upload 3D-files ready for download and printing

Where can I print?

You can print at various location free, or some against payment. If you are a student at DTU, you can print for free at FabLab building 414, which only requires a one hour introduction. You also have DTU Sky-

Lab, but you can only use it for a study related project. If you are not a DTU student, you can go to 3DPrinthuset in Copenhagen, which only costs a small amount. They also sell printers that you can buy for personal use. The cheapest they have costs DKK 5.500.-

3D printers are expensive... Or are they?

If you buy a factory produced 3D-printer, it will often cost the amount of 2xPlaystation 4(DKK 6000), but you can also get a printer that is cheaper. If you check ebay.com, you'll find, though less sophisticated, printers at around DKK 2500-3500. These printers work fine, but with lower precision. If you want something cheaper, it will have to be a assembly kit, or your own DIY project.

Make your own printer!



You can make your own printer for a relative low amount of money- if you are smart, and have some finger dexterity, it will cost about DKK 500-600. You can find plenty of guide on the internet that explain how to make your own 3D-printer, but they do not always same on material. Search on Google: Ewaste 3D-printer. This is a DIY project where you, with relative few resources, can

make a 3D-printer from 2DVD-drives and 1 Floppy-drive. This writer is already in the process of making the 3D printer, and the finished result should look something like the picture below.
