## A lack of new residents on new positions!


In spite of it being only two residents who have chosen to withdraw from their positions at the dormitory, it has the consequence that four positions are available.

Is close to what has been achieved. Although there is actually only talk about a facelift to the bar, it has definitely improved the bar's appearance and given it a new style. So far, the response has been very positive, and we are obviously happy.

## Flexibility is the key!

We have tried to create a bar for everyone. A bar for those who want to experience a wild college party, but also a bar for those who may just want to go for a single beer to end a tough week. Hopefully we've found room for everyone. The rooms are very different, as is indicated by the colours alone.

It has been a big focus for us to make booths rather than the previous worn-down tables and chairs. Partly because tables are unhandy, not possible to put together and not very bar-like, and also because the chairs constantly break—who would have thought that about IKEA's cheapest furniture?

We have also created new tables for the booths, and they are in fact not yet completely finished, but it is already a clear improvement that they all fit together in height, and seem to fit the bar.

It gives us many new possibilities!

In addition, it has also given us a lot of air in all the rooms while keeping the same number of seats in some places and actually increasing it elsewhere.

## Still unfinished business

For those unaware, it should be said that the renovation was a time limited affair. Though many, both with and without affiliation with the bar, helped (many thanks to each of

you), we were still really busy right until the end. We were in fact ready to open the bar only minutes before opening. Left are still many tasks and improvements which we look forward to rolling out. The plan for those are to have them made in the course of the next month or two. What these things are, exactly, is not something we would reveal here, but instead familiarize you with as we get it done. However, you have something to look forward to in several areas!

## New possibilities and ways you can help!

The renovation has not only provided new paint and booths. We, along with the renovation, have upgraded some of our equipment behind the bar. One of these being a flat screen, with which we want to promote various offers, upcoming parties and more. These promotional images just need to be made. If anyone out there with is a graphical artist or simply have the talent, then you're welcome to give us a tap on the shoulder—it could well be you we needed.

One does not have to be the bartender to help out in the bar—the same goes for several other committees.

## Much more to come!

Therefore, we have far more ideas up our sleeves than just renovation, although this was the most invasive. The dream is to entice more people to the bar, not necessarily every Friday, but just once in a while. As part of fulfilling this desire, we put our heads together to find

ideas, partly on how to easily lure people in, and partly to how we can make the evening more fun when you're there, whether it's a wild rave party or just a couple of cold beers.

In context, we have several projects we can certainly use your help with if you are interested. Likewise, we would still really like to hear your suggestions.



One of the most important projects for us is to get a beer pong table. Eventually, we would also like to have special offers for just beer pong, so that it would become even more awesome!

## Tournament starts in the first weekend of September!

Fall season has arrived. The first men's match will take place on September 6<sup>th</sup>, where the team is going to try to take revenge from the season first match, where the men lost 0-1 at home. Hopefully it goes better this time!

The ladies have a little more time to prepare for the autumn season. Not until Sunday, September 13<sup>th</sup> will they be running on the field at home against Rigshospitalet's dormitory (RHK). Rigshospitalet's women's team have been awesome so far this season, which has consisted of six wins in the same number of matches and a goal tallying an incredible 32-4. In comparison, Nybrogård's women's team, PONyerner (by association with PO Pedersen's dormitory) struggled in the opposite end, where they still need to find victory. This is mainly due to a major injury from previous season, and several bad injuries to several of the team's profiles who had to sit out much of the spring sea-

son.

## Close match in the men's division

The fight for first place has been intense in the men's division. At the head of the division is Morbærhaven, leading the way with 13 points in 7 matches. By comparison, the dormitory's men's team is in 6<sup>th</sup> place just 4 points behind, and as you know, with three points for a win, it's not a very long way up. A good fall season can quickly turn around.

The first match's opponents from Studentergården is head to head with Nybro prior to the match. Both teams have nine points, and with the previous results in mind, it's set up to be a thrilling match.

Both teams hope to see more new faces ahead of the autumn season, and it can not be stressed enough that all are welcome!

The teams train on the fields at Castel Sant'Angelo Hall, right next to the Netto. The ladies train Monday and Thursday 17:30 to 7:00 p.m. while the Men train twice a week during the period 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Training starts from August 31<sup>st</sup>.

## Newly opened positions

### New treasurer sought

As treasurer, you are responsible for the payment of wages to all employees of the dormitory, i.e. NybroTidende, the Secretariat and the network group. You're also responsible for distributing money to clubs agreed upon at the residents' council. The job is paid.

### New secretary sought

As secretary you participate in all board meetings which takes place once a month. After each meeting, you are responsible for transcribing the report, and sending it in good time. It is also you who sends out the agenda once a month. The job is paid.

### New Key Bearer sought

Key carrier, you have a key to all rooms. I.e. the day someone locks themselves out, they can call a key bearer that will come and unlock their door. This service is also at night. The one locked out pays DKK 50.- the DKK 50. - Goes to the key bearer because he is at constant disposal. The rate is higher at night.

### New exercise club chairman sought

As Chairman of the fitness club you will be responsible for... Everything. It will thus also mean that you can make it what you think is the best, and even put your mark on your own gym!

They obvious responsibilities are that you will be responsible for coordination of cleaning, maintenance of equipment, purchase of new equipment etc.

# BIG room

## Did you know that you can get a bigger room?

At the end of each hall, farthest away from the kitchen, there is a room which is larger than all the others.

One room is usually of 12 m<sup>2</sup>, i.e. 4×3 meters, plus hallway and bathroom.

The large rooms of 16 m<sup>2</sup> are 4 × 4 meters and has, in addition to more room, a larger hall than normal.

These rooms are rented according to an internal waiting list. To get on this list, simply send an email to the secretariat.

Secretariat mail is: sek@nybro.dk

It will take several months before you get a room, so you should make sure you are actively studying and thus occupy the college

long enough for a move to pay off.

When you apply, you can either apply to be on the waiting list for all large rooms, or get on a waiting list in selected rooms, for example. all AB or EC-even.

The Secretariat will notify you when they have received your mail and thus put you on the waiting list.

The rent is basically the same for a big as a small room. However, it will play a role in Heat etc. the room has two exterior walls and has a larger area.

When moving in there will be created an overlap of two weeks. Therefore, you should expect to pay 50% rent extra that month.

### Pensum.dk

On Pensum.dk you can both search for and deal in used textbooks and compare prices on new books.

### Book sale in Helligåndskirken

In Helligåndshuset on Strøget in Copenhagen (next to the Holy Spirit), they set up a huge book sale a few times a year where you can buy non-fiction and fiction books.

At the book sale are thousands of books on all sorts of subjects ranging from crime literature and language history to physics, geology and engineering. At the beginning of the book sale, books cost about DKK 80.- but over a period of four weeks, prices fall as low as DKK 5.- There are also new books each day throughout the period until the books cost DKK 5.- The current book sale lasts through d. September 6<sup>th</sup>.

### Amazon

If your books are in English, it may pay to check if you can find them used on the British version of Amazon ([www.amazon.co.uk](http://www.amazon.co.uk)). Remember that although the selection might be wider on the American version of the Amazon, the books are not necessarily cheaper after having taxes applied (packages coming from outside Europe are often stopped by customs).

### Studiz

Studiz have, on their website [www.studz.dk](http://www.studz.dk), collected a wide range of student discounts ranging from online and local student discounts for special temporary study deals. Studiz is also available as a free app that provides access to a digital student card, so you have an overview of where the study discounts are available.

ATTENTION! Not all places advertise student discount, so it is always worth asking.

### Make a meal plan

By making a weekly meal plan, limiting

yourself to shopping only once a week, you'll avoid spending too much money on impulse purchases. If you need inspiration, you can at [rema1000.dk](http://rema1000.dk) get help with making a meal plan, or you can visit [su-mad.dk](http://su-mad.dk) if you are looking for an even cheaper alternative.

### Opskrifter.dk - Empty the fridge

Most people know the days when you only have a few ingredients in the refrigerator and you have no idea what to use them for. On [Opskrifter.dk](http://Opskrifter.dk), there's a feature called Empty the refrigerator, where you can enter the ingredients you currently have in your fridge, and it will then propose different dishes, and indicate which of your ingredients are included in the dish. This way you save money and avoid food waste.

### Tilbudonline or Tilbudsgugen

I can only speak for ST-even's situation. Although ST-even and Odd were in the same boat on May 12<sup>th</sup>, ST-Odd was hit far harder than us!

Huge thanks to all those kitchens that still have their doors open to us when it comes to borrowing utensils, internet and showing general interest and support. It's a long-term game of ST's out in, but the fact is that if you ask me, this has been a humbling, unique, fun and different experience with ST's beautiful residents, that I actually wish I had been without. **#Em-S24**

## Timeline

### **4am May 12<sup>th</sup>.**

- Fire starts in ST-wing lower left kitchen.
- One occupant is taken into observation because of smoke poisoning, but everyone else were out in quick succession.
- 12am we can go to our rooms and retrieve a few belongings.

### **Maj 13<sup>th</sup>**

- All residents are distributed around the country. Some borrow rooms and sleep with hospitable Nybrogensere, others with family, friends or in hotels.

### **May 18<sup>th</sup>**

- The damage to the building is assessed. The 52 rooms and hallways are damaged by soot in varying degrees. The four shared kitchens and roof are completely burned down.
- Fire cause investigated by police and fire authorities.
- It will be necessary to rehouse all residents. All individuals are re-homed according to their insurance.
- Many of those with insurance have stowed all their stuff as they need to clean.
- Those without insurance will be responsible for cleaning their own things.

### **May 22<sup>nd</sup>**

- The rooms on the ground floor are judged as badly damaged as well as the hall and the common areas.
- Rooms on the first floor look a little better.
- Five wagons with two apartments in each

will be set up. Those who live in the carriages are KAB's resettlement and some with insurance who have chosen this option as housing.

### **May 29<sup>th</sup>**

- Demolition of the four kitchens are underway.
- The ground floor rooms have their doors replaced, the floors in the rooms are replaced after individual assessment. All rooms are painted. Floors and ceilings in hallways replaced, all the walls in the hallways are cleaned. It's not yet possible to say anything about how long it will take.
- Cleaning the rooms on the first floor is finished. Restoration of the floor and ceiling of the corridor are carried out. Repairs of damaged doors are carried out.
- Contents of uninsured stored in containers set up on the grass.

### **June 4<sup>th</sup>**

- Concrete deck must be rebuilt. This means the design of concrete work and subsequent reconstruction.
- It is expected that the common kitchens is ready at the beginning of 2016 at the earliest.
- Kitchen pavilion is set up on the grass area.

### **June 9<sup>th</sup>**

- 1st floor gets official permission to move into their apartments again in about a month after the fire.
- Because the doors were kicked in by the fire department, the doors are equipped with padlocks. We must collect mail from

Lars-Kaj.

- There is no official announcement about the cause of fire and the case is closed.

### **June 12<sup>th</sup>**

- It is expected to take about 3 months before the rooms on the ground floor can be occupied again.

### **June 24<sup>th</sup>**

- First actual joint celebration for ST-Equal and Odd in our new "circus tent"

### **July 28<sup>th</sup>**

- Ekstra magazine's headline is "pyromaniac confesses new large-fire, 70 young people were in danger at dormitory." A person has confessed to setting fire to the dormitory. The person has schizophrenia and pyromania diagnosis and mentions he has "a relationship with the college."

### **Week 33**

- Kitchen pavilions updated to more people.

### **August 15<sup>th</sup>**

- Residents begin to move back into ST-Even. All the rooms where residents have moved out, are still empty.

### **Status**

- Many of the ST-odd residents still have their furniture or clothes stored by their insurance company.
- ST-odd are still retrieving mail at Lars-Kaj.
- Some of ST-odd live in carriages, while others live with parents since the fire.

### **October 1<sup>st</sup>**

ST-Odd should be able to move back into their rooms and use the pavilion kitchens.

# Foodcolumn - Seasonal foods

There are many benefits to eating food according to the season - you get a greater variety in your meals, you take into account the environment, and best of all, there is far more flavour and freshness in seasonal fruits and vegetables than those who are out of season.

In addition, fruits and vegetables are cheaper when in season.

As we move into the month of September, many lovely roots are back in season, including beetroot. To take better advantage of the beetroot, receiving more vitamins and fibre, you can eat it raw, for example in a delicious salad like this:

[Crispy beetroot salad with apple and currant dressing \(for two people\)](#)

**What you need:**

**Salad**

- 400 g beetroot
- 1 apple
- 1 handful of hazelnuts
- fresh herbs may be added, but is not necessary

**dressing**

- ½ cup concentrated black currant juice

- 2 tbsp. sunflower oil (or another taste neutral oil)
- 1 tbsp. apple vinegar
- 1 tbsp. lemon juice
- salt and pepper

**Procedure:**

Clean and peel the beets. Cut the beetroot and apple julienne (very thin rods). If time is short, both can be grated, using a coarse grater. This reduces the salad's crispness, and can be more sloppy. Mix the concentrated black currant juice with oil, apple vinegar and lemon juice in a bowl, and season with salt and pepper. Then mix the salad with the dressing and sprinkle it with hazelnuts.

Tip! To avoid that your hands are miscoloured by the beets, use plastic gloves or freezer bags.

The crispy beetroot salad fits perfectly with delicious chicken meatballs, which is super easy to make. Moreover, chopped chicken is often on offer, which also makes it a nice cheap dish! Below you can find my recipe for simple but delicious chicken meatballs:

Delicious chicken meatballs (about 20 pcs.)

**What you need:**

- 450 g. Minced chicken
- 1 egg
- 1 large onion or 2 small
- 1/2 carrots
- 3 tbsp. oatmeal (preferably rolled)
- 2 tbsp. flour
- 1 cup milk
- Salt and pepper
- Additional vegetables or herbs, such as scallions, squash or parsley can be added as needed and help to give the meatballs a different twist. Feta can be added if you want to give the meatballs a Greek touch.

**Procedure:**

Mix all ingredients together until you have a uniform paste and put it in the refrigerator for 30 minutes (this is not strictly necessary and may be omitted if time is short).

Form the meat mixture for meatballs and fry them in a pan with taste neutral oil or butter until golden and firm. Cooking time depends on the size of the meatballs. Cut any one of the meatballs in half and see whether it's pink in the middle, if not, then your meatballs are finished.

Beetroot salad can be served with grilled / fried chicken breast, ordinary meatballs or hamburgers. Limited only by imagination!



## June and July 2015

The average temperature in June this year was 12.7 C°. The average from 2001 to 2010 was 14.6 degrees. Precipitation this year was 59mm, where the average from 2001-2010 was 68mm. The number of hours of sunshine in June was 209 hours

while the previous year was at 239 hours. The average temperature in July this year was 15.5 C° and the average from 2001-2010 is 17.4 C°. Rainfall this year was 86 mm while it was previously at 77mm. We've had 211 hours of sunshine, the previous average was 232 hours.

Maybe because July 2014 was the second warmest since 1874 and the seventh sunniest since 1920. Record the number of summer days. There were 10 local tropical days, two nationwide heat waves, one lasting 14 consecutive days. Nationwide heatwave 5 lasting consecutive days.
