


Sade, Markis de: A French nobleman who lived in the time before, during and after the French Revolution. Gave its name to sadism because of his books about it sexually arousing others through pain.

Amendment to the Rules of Procedure of the Residents' Council and the Statutes of the College
V. the Board

Each proposal was presented and voted.

Each point will be taken in order. (Look in the Annex for more information)

Change in the Rules of Procedure:
It is desired that the residents' council can be a quorum with 8 members being present rather than

half of the residents' council, as is the case now. This should be changed because in some cases it has not been possible to have half the members present and thereby constitute a quorum.

It is therefore wanted changed from: *"The Residents' Council is a quorum when at least half of its members or their alternates are present"* To *"The Residents' Council is a quorum when at least 8, or half, of its members or their alternates are present"*

There is agreement on the proposed change

Changes to the statutes:

As the ordinance trumps the dormitory statutes (Ordinance §15), this says that extraordinary residents' meetings may be requested by the Board (Ordinance, section 16), as it's desired to change the Dormitory statutes §6, paragraph 1 is changed from:

"Extraordinary general meetings

are held at the request of the residents' council or 40 members of NYK."

To "Extraordinary general meetings are held at the request of the residents' council, the board or 40 members of NYK."

For: 9, Abstain: 2 Against: The change are adopted.

In the statutes, it's stated that extraordinary residents' meeting cannot be convened after May 15th. This is inappropriate in relation to resolving follow-up points from the board meeting held in April. The rule is therefore requested changed from: "Extraordinary Residents' Meetings can not be held from May 15th to September 1st and from November 30th to January 2nd"

To "Extraordinary Residents' Meetings can not be held from June 15th to September 1st and from November 30th to January 2nd"

It's requested that an addition is made to the provisions regulating the power to bind the union "The Residents' Council chairman and the treasurer have the power to bind the union"

The rule could be added to the statutes of Section 7 (Finance) as a new paragraph. 9 (does not already exist).

For: 11, Abstain: 0 Against: 0 There is agreement on the proposed change.

This involves access to the various accounts. It should be changed from: "The Residents' Council chairman and the treasurer are both assigned authority to NYKs account. A representative from the network group and the treasurer are assigned authority to the network group account. "

To "The Residents' Council chairman and the treasurer are given authority over all NYKs accounts (NYK, NET and Kitchen coffer)."

It will make it easier compared to

change the treasurer. In addition, the network group will have access the account.

For: 2, Abstain: 7 Against: 2 As the majority have abstained, the point is waived.



Gumball 3000

This year's Gumball 3000 from Dublin to Bucharest has just been completed, and although it might have gone unnoticed by you, do not worry, this article'll give you a brief insight into the car geeks' loud and petrol fueled paradise.

Gumball 3000 is an annual 3,000-mile (4,800 km) international rally on public roads. Each year, a wide range of supercars participate, all wrapped in colorful foil. Gumball 3000 is also called a rich man's rally, since it costs about DKK 350,000 To sign up - which makes it reserved for those few. Over the years, several well-known individuals, such as David Hasselhoff who also attended this year in a red Audi R8 V10, have participated. Last year, the world champion in Formula 1, Lewis Hamilton, attended from Los Angeles to Las Vegas in a Koenigsegg Agera HH owned by the Danish racing driver and entrepreneur David Heineemeier Hansson. Gumball 3000 was started in 1999 by racing driver, entrepreneur and fashion designer Maximillion Cooper, with the aim of combining all his hobbies; fancy cars, design, and entertainment

Over the years there have been many spectacular 3,000-miles routes such as Stockholm to Las Vegas (2015), London to New York (2010), and San Francisco to Beijing (2008). Those who have mastered their geography will now note that these cities are not connected by land masses, but it can be done because planes are obviously rented to all the participants and their cars when the world's oceans have to be crossed ... so the registration fee has some benefits.

Gumball is one of those kinds of competitions where it's only about participating. The idea is that you drive during the day and party at night and since you drive on public roads, it's not really about finishing first. There is, however, a "Spirit of The Gumball" award, which this year went to Team Afrojack.

Seasonal foods



Summer has arrived, and what better suits summer than summer foods! Cold potato salad and meatballs is a classic summer combination. In this recipe I have chosen to make chicken meatballs, as they are a little easier, which I think fits better with the summer heat.

Creamy cold potato salad

Ingredients (4 persons):

- 1 kg of small washed potatoes
- 3 dl sour cream, 18%
- 2.5 cups of mayonnaise (it tastes best with HellMann mayonnaise)
- 1 tbsp. dijon mustard
- Salt and pepper
- 3 finely chopped spring onions

- You can also add
- 1 bundle of radishes, sliced
- 1 bundle of chives, finely sliced

Procedure:

Making potato salad is a little time consuming, because the potatoes should be boiled and cooled down before they mixed with the dressing. Therefore, it is easiest to work with potatoes that are cooked the day



before. Alternatively, you can cook them until they are soft and let them cool under running cold water. Take a large bowl and mix sour cream, mayonnaise and mustard with salt and pepper. taste the cream and add, if necessary, more mustard, salt, and pepper. Potatoes also suck a lot of flavor.

Rinse the spring onions and cut them into thin slices. If you choose to add radishes and chives, cut radishes into thin slices and chop the chives fine. Then turn the potatoes in cream with onions and half of the radishes and chives. When serving, you can decorate the potato salad with the leftovers.

Tip! Potato salad can easily be prepared the day before and rest in the cream, do, however, not add scallions, radishes, and chives until the day after, this will allow you to avoid losing the fresh taste.

Chicken meatballs

Ingredients (About 20 balls.):

- 450 g of ground chicken meat
- 1 egg
- 1 onion
- 2 tbsp. flour
- 2 tbsp. oat meal
- 1 cup milk
- Salt and pepper

finely grated vegetables (optional, for example: 1 carrot or ¼ squash)

Procedure

Grate or chop the onion and stir in the minced chicken meat in a bowl. Add the flour, oatmeal and eggs. If wanted, grate a carrot or a piece of squash and stir in with the milk, salt and pepper.

Add 1 large tablespoon of the mix and sear


