

The Nerd's Copenhagen

There are numerous guides to what to eat in Copenhagen, where to shop and what attractions there are to see (just look at page 5 of this edition of NybroTidende). But how can you satisfy your board game hunger?

First, it's worth noting; the guide is aimed at people who are interested in games of different variants - stamp collectors, rock geeks and tractor enthusiasts will hardly get their interest covered in this article. The following recommendations can peak the interest of everyone from comfort-Settlers players to hardcore Magic geeks

SHOPS

Nerd shops can often be hidden away, but particularly in the inner city will you be able to find a lot if you have the patience to look around a little. Faraoes Cigarer, a true geek mecca, is among the largest - and fortunately, one of their shops is located as close as at Lyngby Station. Here you will find all types of collectibles from wild costumes to graphic novels, magic cards and board games. There is also ample opportunity to play a few games of magic on the first floor. Immediately nearby in Jorchs Passage and Sankt Peders Stræde you will find **Fantask, Fuglsang & co.** and **Games**, which is somewhat more specialized. Fantask mainly sells books, cartoons and movies in countless genres. Hogsmeade-like Fuglsang & co. puts focus on costumes and exclusive collectibles and Games put focus on, yes, games.

CAFÉ and bars


Bastard Café in Huset KBH must be Denmark's unconditional board game paradise. Here are hundreds and hundreds of board games of all kinds, some of them cost little to play, others are completely free. Here it is allowed to eat packed lunches and snacks (although it is also possible to buy snacks, coffee and space-beer), which means that you can easily play a whole Sunday off here.

If you prefer games that contain ping sounds and lots of flashes, the arcade bar, with the very descriptive name, **bipbipbar** is also recommended.

For those seeking a more café-like atmosphere to play board games, there is a fair amount of cafes with "standard games" like Trivial Pursuit or chess. The writer's favorite, **Café Present** at Nørregade, is recommended and has great coffee which comes cheap.

A little closer to DTU is a board game and role-playing club, which is part of the PF: **PFantasy Dome**. Here is a wide selection of free games, and the site at DTU can be quite enticing for many. The club is open every Monday from 5pm

Even closer is Nybrogård's own board game club, **The Board**, which is now open every Tuesday! The Board is located in the CD-basement and has so far collected a good



amount of games. In connection with its recent opening, we also bring a pair of recommendations from the club's board that can get winter evenings to go a little faster and cozier.

EVENTS

Finally, there are various geek events around Copenhagen. **Nerd Market**, a group of geeks that can be found on Facebook promotes and organizes a lot of events; including Nerd Market in Copenhagen (surprise) with the sale of various nerd gear and nerd-New Year celebration.

THE BOARD RECOMMENDS

1. Settlers of Catan. Catan is a true classic. With over 20 years behind it, it is a game that still holds. The rules are simple and are quickly learned. A strategy game for 2-5 players in which each player takes on the job as head of a colony on an island. It's about acting, building and negotiating your way to being the first to have built cities, made roads and reign over the most land!

2. Munchkin. Another classic that has brought joy and smiles for many years. Munchkin is, in short, a card game where each player is a fictional adventurer who must defeat a lot of monsters and kick down doors in order to find a lot of great loot! The game is filled with pop references and glorious geek humor. From D&D to Star Wars and everything in between. The game is easy to learn and most can participate.

3. Lost Patrol. Lost Patrol is a new game which was released this year. It is a game for 2 people and is about surviving a plane crash on a remote planet. Each player takes either the role of the fearless Space Marines scouts or the extremely dangerous and malicious Genestealer Aliens who are just hungry. It is a simple and fast game that is fun and hard to win if you all want to get off the planet alive.



Copenhagen for exchange students and other "newbies": *Nørrebro and Vesterbro*

Last month we described Copenhagen's tourist spots, here is a guide to some of Copenhagen's less touristy, but nonetheless unique, modern and lively areas: Nørrebro and Vesterbro. From being districts with pretty bad reputations, the districts are, today, competitive "hipster hubs", which offer a vast array of restaurants, bars and cafes.

NØRREBRO

We start with the shawarma centre, Nørrebro. As soon as you cross the Queen Louise Bridge you will see kebab restaurants on all sides, and attractive cheap prices. Whether you are at Nørrebrogade in search of good lunch specials or a round of drunken-kebab too late at night, there is always time in kebab street. Among others, Take & Eat (large selection of fresh ingredients), Five Star (Indian kebab) and King of kebab (cheap!) are recommended. If you want a bigger culinary journey than just to the Middle East, you need not look long; at Nørrebro you can find everything from Ethiopian flat bread (Ma'ed) to Asian street kitchen (Aroii).

Specific tourist attractions are scarce on Nørrebro there are, however, many places where you can enjoy Nørrebro's cozy atmosphere with to-go coffee or picnic. Good places to hang out include the lakes, Blågårdsplads or Superkilen. The latter, Superkilen, consists of a green area, The Black Square and Red Square, which offers a green and colourful dash to the district. At the same time, Superkilen works as part of Copenhagen's cycling "highway", Den Grønne Kile, extends from Frederiksberg to the North West. Superkilen's special architecture has also won international awards for its multi-ethnic character.

Finally, Nørrebro has plenty of bars to offer: try, among other, the table tennis bar

Dupong, cozy Understellet, cheap Mexibar or Mikkellers' delicious beer.

VESTERBRO

Vesterbro also boasts a Mikkeller-beer bar and the equally excellent beer at Fermentoren. Vesterbro also has a similar wide range of restaurants, many of which are centred around Vesterbrogade or Købdbyen at Sønder Boulevard. E.g. Madglad (which serves very cheap, healthy food), Mad og Kaffe, Vesterbros Originale Burgerrestaurant and Neighborhood (with pizza and cocktails) can be recommended. In the common house Absalon on Sønder Boulevard you can get a cheap meal for 50 kr. Every day at 6pm - or you can participate in the house's other crazy and different activities like chair dance tournaments, yoga for novices, bingo, swing dancing or bridge tournament. Absalon is incredibly popular with the Vesterbro locals, but is open to all.


Finally, Vesterbro has a small but interesting selection of "tourist" worthy attractions. The most famous attraction is undoubtedly Carlsberg, where you can take guided tours of Carlsberg and its beer's history, but the district also has several galleries and museums. Additionally, there are, like at Nørrebro, many commendable sites. The aforementioned Sønder Boulevard, previously unattractive, violence- and drug hit, the street is now a green and vibrant boulevard with lots of activities, great for people-watching. If you are looking for a more relaxed area, the park "Skydebanen" should be explored. One part of the park is bounded by a single giant wall, which gives the park a special touch. In addition there is a fantastic playground (granted, I've also tried it as an adult) and good seating.

The minutes are approved. However, it is noted that Karoline T65 joined as a member of the residents' council at the last meeting.
5. Review of last board meeting or agenda.
A brief summary of the points discussed at the September meeting:

There was a company looking at a water budget where money could be saved. They gave an offer that could ultimately save the dormitory money. However, it will mean that there will be fewer litres of water from the various taps. But it should not cause any daily annoyances.

Gladsaxe municipality has still not purchased the land of the kindergarden, and it is therefor still not sold. But negotiation is still taking place.

Negotiation of new insurance is taking place that will result in a saving of 30,000 kr. annually.

Gladsaxe has long wanted new sewers as they are old. But it is not yet known when this project will start.

Vester Forbrænding are starting on district heating. It is estimated to be up and running in a month's time. 240,000 kr will be saved as a result.

Election of Board positions will soon take place if anyone is interested.
6. Economy
All but one hall has enrolled kitchen

coffer.

The \$ 800 which was awarded every kitchen can still be applied for until the New Year. The kitchen can also buy stuff then send the receipt to Kasper. Both kitchens have 800kroner so a total of 1,600 kr. Per. hall.

7. Other messages
At the last meeting it was decided to give KælderCaféen 16,000 kr. for payment of a bill. This is no longer relevant, since it has been decided that it can get the same terms as private celebrations. This means that KODA tax is not required to be paid.

Canoe budget

There are some things in canoe and kayak club in need of repair and replacing. Therefore, a total of 56,200 kr, split among three items is sought. Repairs 20.450 kr, Kayaking 20,000, canoeing 15,750. All entries must be discussed individually. Budget is attached.

The green / yellow kayaks needs to be replaced, this will be done in two steps. Some select sea kayaks with glass fibres have been chosen, which are more durable. They will be delivered within a week.

A canoe has been stolen, so there is a need for a new one. It will have a bottom, so you can sit in it and be fit more in it. And there will be seats that can be removed.

It was discussed whether it was a good time to buy now, at the end of the season. To this was explained that we have been given an intro deal on kayaks. Furthermore, it will allow us to use the fall to deal with all repairs.

It was noted that there are discrepancies between the budget and the total amount

applied for. This is due to a formality and have no significant impact on the total amount applied for. All purchases are considered to be made in the autumn.

It is desired that the three points will be voted on separately.

Seasonal foods



When autumn has really made its impression with cold and rainy weather it is always nice with some hot food. Here, a soup is perfect, and nothing is more delicious than a nice creamy potato leek soup!

Creamy potato leek soup with bacon

Ingredients (about 4 servings):

- 500g potatoes
- 2 large leeks
- 1 onion
- 2 cloves of garlic
- 100g cream cheese naturel
- A little cooking cream or Cremefine
- 3/4 l vegetable broth (you can also use chicken stock)
- Butter for frying
- Salt and pepper

Garnish:

- Small portion of shredded leeks
- 150g of bacon

Possible to add chives

Procedure:

Peel the potatoes and cut them into pieces. Wash leeks and cut them, likewise, into pieces - save a chunk of leeks for garnish. Chop the onion and fry it in a little butter with garlic. Add the vegetables and saute over low heat for 10-15 minutes - the vegetables should not take color. Then add the broth and cook for 20 minutes.



Potato leek soup is perfect for the colder autumn days, and the creamy taste with the crispy fried bacon is a guaranteed winner!

Meanwhile, fry the bacon in a frying pan or in the oven until crisp. Let it cool on a little towel to make it extra crispy.


When the vegetables are ready-cooked, blend the soup into a uniform consistency - either with a hand blender or in a blender. You may want to pour it through a sieve if you want to get rid of the leek strips and the like, but this is not vital. Stir the cream cheese into the soup - if you do not have the patience to stir until it dissolves, you can blend it a little with the hand blender and add cooking cream, salt and pepper to taste. Garnish the soup with crushed, crispy bacon, fresh leeks (if you don't like the fresh taste, you can give them a quick fry) and some chives.

TIP! Serve with a rough garlic bread. It tastes amazing!

Pumpkin is not the only thing the kitchens have in common. Ducks are also a recurring theme at both halls.


On EF-odd they have a fine coat rack with ducks to hold their towels.

Cosy Decorations and personality are certainly aplenty on EF.




The pretty personal drawings on EF-odd's fridges.

1. GET SOME HELPERS

- 1) Make food without regard to preferences,
- 2) Make something simple like burgers or tacos, where there is great freedom of choice
- 3) Make a single dish that meets everyone's needs - and try something new. The Internet is once again your friend - there are meat, gluten- and lactose-free alternatives to almost all dishes.

So get out the pans and pots and make something delicious for your kitchen!
