

Snaps and Christmas

What is a Christmas party without Christmas snaps? According to many, "haps haps haps" and the subsequent snaps is absolutely essential. But if this editor (and probably many others) is honest, there are actually many kinds of snaps that can be a relief to avoid. This article brings you a small selection of snaps, from the big, wide world of snaps that both you and your Christmas party partners can enjoy to any "skål".

To find the right approach and good recipes we have teamed up with Rasmus from AB-even. According to him, it is actually quite easy to brew snaps - the actual production of snaps often takes only 5-20 minutes, and then the snaps does the rest of the work right up to the filtration. There are a few important things you should remember. First and foremost you naturally need a container—here, glass bottles or other glass containers such as discarded beetroot glasses work well. The added alcohol certainly does not need to be snaps - vodka (and even the relatively cheap, like Karvedys) can easily be used. The Vodka's very neutral flavour makes room for taste impressions from the rest of the ingredients.

After the vodka is poured over the ingredients, the snaps really just needs to sit until it has a sufficiently strong flavour. This can take a few days to several years—it all depends on the ingredients and your personal preferences. Depending on how long snaps needs to infuse, it should be shaken frequently: almost every day for snaps with short infusion times but less often for snaps with longer infusion time. According to Rasmus it is the brewer's unfortunate (read: quite delicious!) duty to taste the snaps during the process until you end up with a snaps with comfortable strength. If it is too strong it can, of course, be diluted with more vodka. Finally, the snaps is filtered through a sieve and, if necessary, coffee filters.

One can use a variety of ingredients from the nature, gardens, or Netto's many shelves. Besides the following Christmas snaps, honey snaps, ginger snaps, liquorice snaps and Aabo snaps (blackcurrant snaps in Jerrycan originating in CD-even), are all incredibly delicious! Try a few recipes and find your own favourite!

CHRISTMAS SNAPS RECIPE

This snaps both smells and tastes like Christmas - and it needs such a short infusion time that you are able to finish it before Christmas and January's Christmas parties.



Ingredients

- 1 orange
- 1 vanilla pod
- 60g sugar
- ½ cinnamon stick
- 8 cloves
- 40 coffee beans
- 1 bottle of vodka



A splendid snaps collection can be found at AB-even!

USE NATURE

Fir: the spring's fir-shoots (but also autumn withered fir), provides a snaps that smells wonderfully of Christmas. Give the snaps 14-30 days to infuse - possibly with a vanilla pod and a few fennel seeds - and it is ready for filtering!

Juniper berries: a handful of black second year juniper berries, which can still be found in nature, a bottle of vodka and a whole lime's peel, will in only three weeks become a tasty snaps completely ready for filtration.

Rowanberries: You can still be lucky and find rowan around e.g. Lyngby Lake. Leave them in the freezer for at least two days (or pick them up after frost), add, if necessary, a vanilla pod, and then give the mixed snaps 6 weeks before it is filtered.

Blackthorn: It's on the verge of being too late in the year to brew this snaps, but the overwhelming marzipan-like taste is worth the effort- if only for next year! The Blackthorn should, like the rowan berries, be frozen beforehand and the snaps should infuse for a few weeks to a few months.

Procedure: For this snaps you need to use a large, 1-liter jar as an entire orange needs to fit (alternatively: try with orange peels)

- 1) Make small holes in the orange and place it in the glass.
 - 2) Add split vanilla pod, sugar and coffee beans.
 - 3) Add cloves and the half cinnamon stick-possibly in a tea bag so that the taste does not become too pervasive.
- Let the snaps infuse for 3-4 weeks prior to filtration. Remember to shake it continually.

Since the old treadmill in the fitness club is at its end, a request is hereby made for the purchase of a new one. The treadmill has been investigated and a repair would cost around 5000 kr. Which is probably not worthwhile because the treadmill is very old and worn out. Money to buy a brand new treadmill is therefore sought instead, which should last for many years into the future. The reason is we are requesting a brand new treadmill is to ensure that it can last for many years, since we have no guarantees when purchasing a used model. Unfortunately it is also the most expensive equipment we have, but also a tool that is indispensable to have in the club since it is

used very often. It is quite important that we get a treadmill of decent quality, otherwise it quickly wears out and breaks down again.

There are various options for buying a new one and cost and quality are of course related. So the question is how much we want to invest, as the risk of it being worn down quickly will be a lot higher if you buy a cheaper model.

I've studied a lot of suggestions and have found three sensible offers, all set in different price ranges and thus quality. The proposals are in order of preference:

B) Revised user agreement for K-Net

V. Netgroup

The Network Group has made a complete revision of the user agreement. The review

has several purposes: Reflect changes to the "new" setup at K-net, improve the experience of the shared Wi-Fi's "K-Net" by regulating private Wi-Fi's, describe the user's rights better, specify the sanctions better, describe our response time in case of crashes better (and shorten them), and make the agreement more legally correct.

We have established that many private Wi-Fi's are a direct cause of the bad connection for some users. We are aware that restrictions to private Wi-Fi's will be difficult for some residents to meet, but we believe that one should be able to manage their private Wi-Fi's (to avoid exposing other residents to malicious access or diminish the signal of "K-Net"). We will also provide general guidelines to modify the relevant settings on a router access point and send

them before the changes take effect.

At the residents' meeting we would like to discuss the content and possibly make minor changes. The statement would then be put to a vote and the suggested date in which it will take effect is February 1st 2017. The new statement will be made accessible to all current users by a change acc. The current statement § 7 paragraph.

Mother Of Cakes 2016

Ingredients (about 10 persons), 150 g dark chocolate, 150 g butter, 150 g sugar, 100 g pasteurized egg yolks, 120 g pasteurized egg whites, 50 g almonds (without shell), 50 g sugar.

1. Melt chocolate and butter in a bowl over a water bath. 2. Beat the egg yolks and 100g sugar until fluffy in another bowl. 3. Gently stir the chocolate mixture into the egg mixture. 4. Beat the egg whites in a third bowl, mix 50 grams of

sugar in, a little at a time. 6. Turn the meringue in the chocolate mixture. 7. Spread half of the mousse in a spring form (18 cm in diameter). 9. Bake it at 175 degrees for about 25 minutes, and then put it in the refrigerator.

- While the cake bakes, the pralinéen is made:

1. Caramelize 50g sugar in a small pan. 2. Mix the almonds in the caramel and pour it immediately onto a cutting board covered with wax paper. 3. Allow to cool completely, and chop it

coarsely. 4. Put the pralinéen on top of the cooled base and spread the rest of the mousse on the bottom.

Put the finished cake in the refrigerator and let it sit overnight. 1. Loosen the cake from the edge and bottom with a knife. 2. Give it a fine sprinkle of cocoa and garnish it with macarons.

NybroTidende's food column:

Seasonal foods

In December, rice porridge is almost mandatory, but if you don't want to eat it for the whole month, you can happily use the porridge for other delicious dishes. Nybro-Tidende therefore provide some interesting ideas about what you can use the lovely porridge for, if you get tired of cinnamon and butter.

Rice porridge (for 2 people)

Ingredients:

180g porridge rice
3 cups water
1 liter of milk (I used low-fat milk)
 $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. Salt

Procedure:

Pour water and rice in a pot and let it cook for about 2 minutes. Add the milk and bring to boil while stirring. Cook the porridge with the lid on, at low heat, making sure to stir it regularly so the milk does not burn. Cook it for about 40 minutes or until it has a firm consistency. Taste the porridge with a little salt and serve with cinnamon sugar and a knob of butter.

Blob Cakes (for 2 people)

Ingredients:

350 g of rice porridge
1 tbsp. wheat flour
1 tbsp. Milk
1 egg
 $\frac{1}{2}$ tbsp. Sugar

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. vanilla sugar

Butter for frying

Procedure:

Stir the flour and milk into the porridge. Beat the eggs and add them with sugar and vanilla sugar. Melt the butter in a hot pan. When the butter has melted, the dough is put on the pan in blobs. Bake until light brown on both sides. Tip! Make sure to spread the dough out a little, so that the cakes are not too thick- or else it takes too much time to complete and is difficult to flip.

Risalamande (for 4 persons)

Ingredients:

500 g of rice porridge
50 g almonds
2 tbsp. Sugar
1 tbsp. vanilla Sugar
2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups whipping cream

Procedure:

The almonds are blanched and chopped finely - coarsely chopped almonds can also easily be used. Personally, coarsely chopped almonds in risalamande gives me associations with uncooked rice, but it is completely up to you.

After you've chopped the almonds they are mixed with the cooled porridge. Whip the cream in another bowl until it becomes whipped cream and fold it into the porridge a little at a time. Add sugar and vanilla and add to taste a little more vanilla (vanilla is arguably

the best). Set the risalamande in the fridge until it's ready to be consumed, and serve with cherry sauce.

TIP! Since the rise porridge needs to cool down when you make your risalamande, you can make it the day before so you are sure that it has time to cool down.
