As you probably know, we in the Net-work group have created a forum that will be used instead of using the mail meddelelse@nybro.dk. Therefore meddelelse@nybro.dk is effectively closed per March 7th.

The idea is to use the newly created forum instead. To log in to the forum you need your internet user name and password. You will find the direct link to the forum here: www.nybro.dk/forum.

In the forum you will have access to the hallway-forum you belong to, and the club that you are a member of.

The forum is divided into different categories, so that every user has access to the sub forums that are relevant to them. This has been added to the general forums:

Chit-chat, Buy and Sale, Sport and games, NybroFestival, KælderCaféen, Internet, TV and radio, Telephone, Residents' council, Residents' council minutes.

Furthermore, there is an internal forum for every club and one forum for

each hallway.

The access is controlled via the different hallway mailing lists and club mailing lists, so if you do not have access to a particular club forum, it is due to the chairman not having added you to the corresponding mailing list.

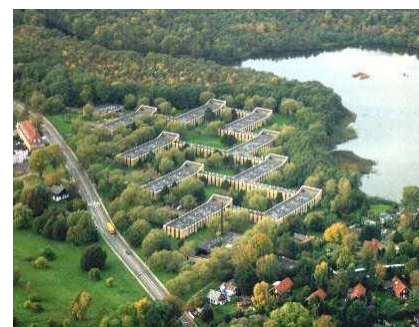
If you are lacking access to your hallway forum, please contact the Network group. Then we will give you access immediately.

The Garden Group is ready for another season

The warm weather has pulled the kitchen garden enthusiasts of the dorm out into their gardens for the year's first preparations.

The gardening season is setting off, because spring means activity in the gardens. After a cold winter, warm winds finally arrived with temperatures up to 17 degrees. And there is plenty for the kitchen garden owners to do – cleaning and preparing their planting beds for the plants to be grown in the coming season.

In order to benefit most from the kitchen gardens, the kitchen garden experts advise that the soil should have a rich flora of worms, microorganisms, bacteria and fungi, which break down the organic plant parts in excrements. And then the things which have lain still all winter should be cleaned up.

Both the garden owners in front of the LM-kitchens and in front of the CD-kitchens have gotten started, and

Minutes of the residents' council meeting Tuesday March 6th 2012

At 19 in the GH-basement

Ad 1) Mikkel J21 has been elected moderator and English is the language chosen.

Ad 2) 12 voting members are present.

Ad 3) Correction to topic no. 7 in the last meeting: the decision in the common complaint has been rejected by the residents' complaint committee. The minutes are otherwise approved.

Ad 4) The agenda is approved.

Ad 5) Economy:

The NYK account has DKK 179,000 and the Network account has DKK 374,000.

There has been paid DKK 11,820 toward salaries for January and February and there has been paid DKK 12,000 to KælderCaféen for a new elevator.

Ad 6) Other news

A reminder from last time: all topics and appendices are to be submitted to the secretary no later than 12.00, ten days prior to the meeting in order to be included in the agenda. Furthermore topics must have more details so everyone knows exactly what it is about. To ease the secretary's work you should send topics in this format: Headline, detailed text and any appendices. Until 8 days prior to the next meeting it is possible to supply any corrections to topics that are already sent in, but it is not possible to send new topics not already part of the original agenda.

Thursday March 1st 2012 there was open house, but since there were no volunteers to be in the stall in DTU or give the tour of the dorm, Jonas D59 did both these tasks.

There is open house in DTU in March and November and in future

this must be planned better and there will hopefully be more participants.

To find a date for an activity party there is sent a doodle that all is asked to reply to, so a date can be found as soon as possible.

There is a meeting in KAB where at the moment 3 dorms have met to exchange experiences about how to best run a dorm, etc.

Ad 7) Board meeting

There has yet to be drafted an agenda for the next board meeting, but there has been held a maintenance meeting where the heat loss bill and the problems with doors and radiators (large rooms and apartments) were discussed. There has already been made a heat loss bill and the doors and radiators will be included in the long term budget. There are other issues that will be further discussed, and more information will be sent about this.

Ad 8A) Logo competition

Gabriel C05 and Jakob C03 have wanted to have a competition where a new logo for the dorm will be created. This logo will then be able to be used by all the dorm's clubs. Three suggestions for a value of the prize have been submitted. The general attitude is that it is too much money, but many also feel that it will make more people want to join in. A fourth option has been more available, granting the possibility of a reduced value of the prize. This requires $\frac{3}{4}$ in favour.

In favour: 3

Opposed: 9.

There will not be a fourth option, but only the three original options will be voted for.

The vote for which of the three options that will be used:

8 votes for option 1 with a value of DKK 500/1000

3 votes for option 2 with a value of DKK 750/1500

1 votes for option 3 with a value of DKK 1000/2000

The value of the prize in the logo competition has been set to DKK 500/1000.

Ad 8B) FC Nybro men's team is applying for DKK 4090.

DKK 4090 has been applied for new equipment. Talks have been made with the girl's team, and discounts are available if both teams purchase it together.

The vote is for DKK 4090, but this money might not all be spent, due to discounts.

In favour: 11

Opposed: 0

Abstain: 1

The FC Nybro men's team will get the DKK 4090 have applied for.

Ad 8C) Presentation of the financial report of KælderCaféen.

The gross income is DKK 25,133.90 and the expenses are DKK 17,335.47 which gives a net income of DKK 7,778.43 in the term November 16th to December 31st 2012. There have been paid DKK 65.33 for old bills, and this means that all bills and expenses from the old KælderCafé have been paid off.

This will not balance out to 0, but the additional funds will be spent on renovation etc, and in the final ens it will balance out to 0.

The budget from 1st quarter this year will be presents at the next meeting.

Ad 8D) New vote on the TV-channels in the dorm.

To proceed with this, a committee has been formed: Thomas C22 and Sarah G06. Simon A26 might be able to help if it becomes an electronic vote.

Ad 8E) The Cake committee is applying to become a club.

The cake committee is applying to become a club with the name "Nybro cake committee" with Maria J34 and Maria O64 as chairmen.

In favour: 12

Opposed: 0

The club is hereby inaugurated.

Ad 8F) DKK 1000 has been applied for the cake festival on March 17th 2012.

This is budgetted for about 150 people, which seems a lot since there currently are 63 signed up on the festival home page.

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This number has been set as the maximum, and everything that is not spent will be saved for the next cake festival. The plan is to host a cake festival every March and October.

In favour: 12

Opposed: 0

The Nybro cake comitee will get the DKK 1000 they applied for.

Ad 8G) Electing a new account responsible for the Network group.

The vote is whether Mikkel J21 should have power of attourney for the account.

In favour: 11

Opposed: 0

Abstain: 1

Mikkel J21 hereby has power of at-tourney to the Network group account along with the treasurer.

Ad 8H) K-net needs a treasurer

K-net needs a treasurer, and Mikkel J21, who currently is representative at K-net, will be withdrawing soon. If no new treasurer can be found by the next general election on March 20th

or if no new representative can be found instead of Mikkel J21 when he withdraws, the dorm will no longer have internet access. Jonas D59 will go to the general election in K-net and will see what will happen and what must be done.

Ad 8I) K-Net plans to raise the dues for internet to DKK 16.50 per 01.01.2013.

The votes is whether to accept this increase. If the votes are opposed, we risk losing our internet if many other dorms vote in favour.

In favour: 11

Opposed: 0

Abstain: 1

This price increase is accepted.

Ad 8J) Setting a comitee to propose changes in the statutes and the business order.

This refers to topic 8I and 8J at the last residents' council meeting, where the dorm statutes and business order were reviewed, and it calls for changes. This group will be responsible for updating it so it fits with how things are done these days.

The comitee is made of: Majbritt S05, Maria J34 and Mikkel J21.

Ad 9) New members and alternates

Lasse C21 is withdrawing

Lærke N47 is withdrawing and Thorbjørn O63 is signing up as the new member on behalf of NO-odd.

Ad 10) Other notes.

A comitee must be appointed, made up of 2 room tenants and 2 apartment tenants who will review the area plan, the heat exchange and electric exchange. This will be decided at the next meeting.

Ad 11) The next residents' council meeting is on Wednesday April 11th 2012 at 20.00 in GH-basement. There will be residents' meeting from 19.00.

The cake festival was a success

The scents of butter, cocoa and coconut fill my nose as I open the door to LM-even. In the hallway outside the common kitchens, a long table is dotted with cakes and people are standing in groups, talking or studying and tasting the cakes. There is no doubt: Nybrogård's Cake Festival 2012 is under way.

LM-even and NO-even set the setting for the dorm's first cake festival, which was held Saturday, March 17th. In each hallway, almost 60 cakes were distributed on a long table. Cakes which the participating residents had brought as admission to the festival. In return, they are allowed to eat all the cake they can – and they do.

Symptoms of sugar chock

Signs show the way to the cake festival, and large posters are hung on the walls around the tables depicting symptoms of sugar chock. The organizers have come up with the various symptoms. Between them, will be found hyperactivity, hallucinations, disinclination to staying upright, several types of diabetes, attempting to ride sleighs down stairs, urge to speak German, cakefobia, octofobia (the fear of the number eight) and a temporary inclination to stay away from any future cake festivals. All of them symptoms, which the organizers promise will pass soon after the cake festival.

The success criteria for the organizers of the cake festival was 50 participants during the planning phase, and when I enter at around 15:00, 70 guests have already passed by. Most arrived for the opening at 12:00, and after three hours of cake, most are full and tired. A whole group of overeating residents has retreated to the right kitchen of NO-even. A few par-

ents have also come by, and a few of the residents have invited guests from outside. Everyone seems to be

very impressed with the festive and ambitious event.

The cakes are judged

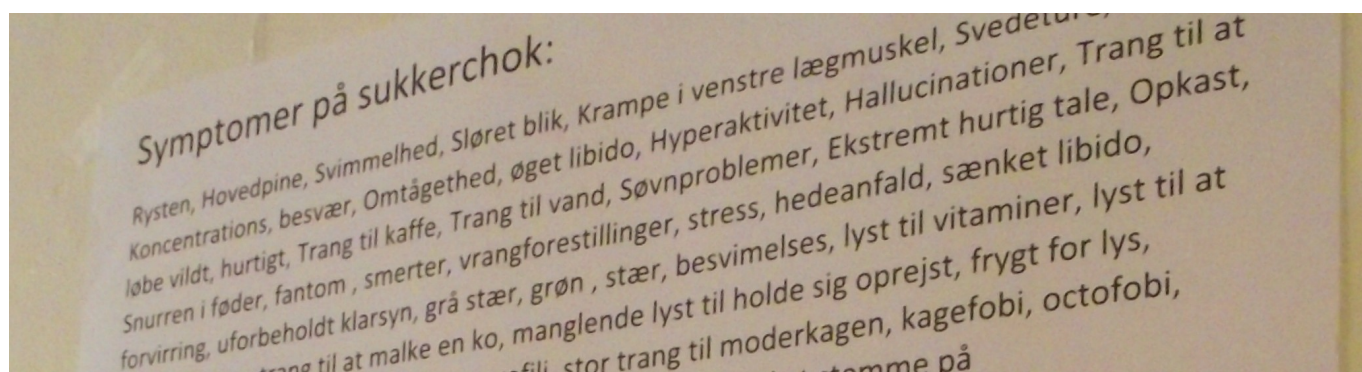
Most of the people that are still at it at the cake tables are cake festival judges, that are appointed to judge the cakes in different categories: The fanciest, the most creative, the most ambitious, the surprise, the 'placenta' ('placenta' is translated to Danish as 'moderkage' or 'mothercake' – implying that the cake is so good your mother must have baked it) and the better-luck-next-time-cake (to the cake that did not live up to the expected standards).

Amongst the judges are Claes, O52 and he takes his job seriously. A cake does not get placed on the table before he appears, ready to slice a piece. Also Lars Kaj acts as judge for the occasion.

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He has been especially impressed with the flat raspberry cake (hindbærsmutter) and other cakes with fruits and nuts. As he himself puts it, he sticks to the 'healthy' cakes. Nonetheless, the cake with a thick layer of brown sugar and butter on top (brunsviger) does not get passed by. "It is like being a kid again," he explains, smiling.

The Nybro cake

Cakes of all shapes and sizes are on the tables. The participants have been creative – showing such creations as beer cake, cinnamon-roll trains, raisin buns, muffins with blue frosting and a cinnamon cake shaped as Nybrogård Kollegiet as seen from a bird's eye view. Maria, J34 has created the very unique Nybro cake, although, as is noted, the original inventor of the concept is Asger, H61. Maria has spent hours baking the cake, creating chocolate windows, frosting on the sides and gummy bears symbolizing the residents of the dorm. There is also a Cartman cake with bacon – inspired by the character from South Park.



23 pieces of cake

Since all participants have brought a cake, it means having to go through almost 60 pieces if you plan on trying each cake. As far as my sources tell me, no one reached that many pieces, although many ate far more than they had thought possible. Cake festival chairman, Ann Louise, N36 starts off nicely with 23 pieces of

cake! And she had plans of eating even more, but whether she did so before the cake festival ended at 17:00 is as of yet not known.

- **Most ambitious cake:** Maria J34 with The Nybro cake
- **Most creative cake :** Malea, Johannes, Alex and Jennie from JK-even with the Burger cake
- **The surprise:** Nichlas and Niklas from LM-even with the Cartman cake
- **The mothercake:** Charlotte, who was the guest of Lærke M52
- **The better-luck-next-time-cake:** Jonas D59 with beer cake

News from the Canoe Club

There have been a lot of changes in the Canoe Club! Read about the latest changes and what the future may bring.

Online booking system

One of the biggest changes is the new online booking system, where it will be possible to book canoes over the net. A similar booking system will also be made for the kayaks when the Network Group has had time to install it. Until then, it is still necessary to sign up on the door for the kayak equipment.

The reason behind the online booking system was that the previous calendar arrangement was not working optimally. Now, it is possible to book a canoe or kayak from your home with ease, and it is also possible to cancel your reservation if you find out that you are not going canoeing after all.

Here is a short introduction to the online booking system for Canoe Club members. To reserve a canoe or kayak, you need to log in with your network account. On the left side of the web page, there is a menu with the title 'Kano'. Under 'reserve canoe', it is possible to reserve canoes and kayaks.

Step 1:

Set the time you wish to reserve the canoe for. It is only possible to reserve seven consecutive days. If you want to reserve canoes for more than seven days, contact the chairman.

Step 2:

Pick the canoes you wish to reserve.

Step 3:

Confirm the reservation.

At the bottom of the reservation window, a schedule of canoe bookings is shown. The canoes shown in the table are marked as 'occupied', and are not shown in the list of possible choices for that time period. If it turns out, you do not need one or more of your reserved canoes, it is possible to cancel the reservations under 'Canoe Reservations'. It would be advisable to do so, if you do not

need the canoes. That way, others can use the canoes in stead. And remember, that a canoe that has not been claimed 20 minutes after the booked time, can be used by others.

The canoe code will be available on the forum at www.nybro.dk, while the kayak code will be sent by e-mail to the address provided under Network Account-login.

Three new canoes

Another piece of good news is that the cluv has purchased three new canoes. Two of them are similar to the large canoes already available in the club, but are smaller and weigh only 43kg compared to 55kg. The club has also purchased a canoe for those who like to go for long trips, and to learn how to use a canoe. The canoe weighs 25kg but is more delicate than the others. That way, there is something for all members, and it is important to take good care of it.

New kayaks and life vests

The last piece of news is that the club has purchased two new kayaks and several new life vests. Later, we will also receive some more new equipment, but it has not been delivered yet. The life vests are donated by Trykfonen, and it is important that they are taken care of. The life vests are for example not designed for sitting on, so do not use them for that.

The new kayaks are smaller and less seaworthy than the old ones, but they are also quicker. It may be a good idea to start out with the old plastic kayaks until you feel comfortable in them before moving on to the new ones.

New kayak-intro course

Purchasing the two new kayaks, means that all old and new members are released from the kayaks. This is done to ensure that everyone knows how to handle and care for the equipment. All members of the kayak club have therefore been deleted, and must be created again if they are interested in using the kayaks. Creating a member entails that the member go through an introductory course for the kayaks.

For the ambitious, a new introductory course is starting every Saturday at 10:00 until April 28th at Frederiksdal Kano- og Kajakskole. After this, there will be a course each month. Read more about the course on the next page.

Lastly, I would just like to wish you a good sailing season! And remember, as more care is taken with the equipment, we can purchase better equipment. So always remember to securely lock the canoes and kayaks after use.

Basic canoe course

All residents in Nybrogård Kollegiet have been offered a canoe course at discount price at Frederiksdal canoe- and kayak school.

All who are interested can sign up in the forum www.nybro.dk under Sport og Spil / Games /kanokursus.

There is space for 12 people or 6 canoes. There can also be created a kayak course if there are enough interested. The date has not been set but will be determined by when there are a suitable number of people. There will probably be a course in the early summer and another in the late summer.

Below is the initiative from Frederiksdal canoe- and kayak school.

A basic canoe course can make you and your friends have a more safe and

relaxing experience while holidaying in Sweden or having a Sunday picnic on Mølleåen (Miller's Creek). With the course you will be introduced to basic paddling exercises, so both fore- and back paddles have a good grip as to which way the canoe is sailing, be it head wind or traversing sharp corners in the rapids. On the course the techniques will be tested in safe conditions under the instruction of competent and experienced trainers. It should be fun to paddle a canoe and we will make sure that you will have the option of challenging each other on the balance and ability to communicate.

With the basic canoe course you will have knowledge about safety in the canoe and will be trained i basic rescue techniques, so you can keep focus if you or the neighboring canoe

should capsize.

The course will among other things include:

- *Introduction to the canoe form and function*
- *Basic paddling exercises*
- *Fun canoe exercises*
- *Advanced paddling exercises*
- *Rescue and balance exercises*

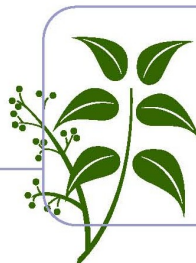

a. Hiring of staff for NybroTidende

Cecilie, D5, who is editor in chief of NybroTidende, has had several inquiries from people who wish to contribute to the paper with either the graphic setup or pictures. It should be discussed in the residents' council what the scope of a NybroTidende-team should be. Who can be hired (with pay), and what tasks (if any) should not be paid

Since the editor can choose the staff, an indicative vote should be held in the residents' council, to give the editor an idea of how many resources the residents wish to spend towards the paper.

It should also be discussed whether it is necessary with a formal hiring procedure when hiring new staff, or if the editor can choose freely whenever someone inquires. A formal procedure would give everyone at the dorm the possibility of applying, but at the same time would demand resources on the part of the editor.

Proposed by Cecilie D05.

b. Recognition for internet upgrade

An enormous piece of work has been done with regards to upgrading the internet, but because the work has been fluent between K-Net and Nybro's network operations, Allan Boll has not received compensation for a large part of the work. The Network group feels he should receive this compensation.

We propose that he receives DKK 5000 from the Network resources as recognition and compensation for his great effort. A vote will be held. Proposed by the Network Group. See appendix.

c. Green Dormitory is looking for a new leader. The current leader, Amanda A21 is moving. Proposed by Amanda A21.

d. The Garden Group proposes that the blackberry bush by the CD-apartments (but not by the canoes) be removed.

This is due to the bushes spreading through the gardens. As it is now, the Garden Group's garden owners in the CD gardens have lost 25% of their gardens, and 3 gardens are completely overgrown. By removing the bushes permanently, this problem will be solved. Proposed by Amanda A21.

e. Problems with gardens 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in the LM gardens.

There are problems with these gardens because the soil is either infertile or so deeply shaded that plants have difficulty growing there. The gardens are protected by the preservation of Lyngby lake (Naturfredningen af Lyngby sø), so the possibilities of improving these gardens are limited. Some trees, that were originally intended to be bushes can be pruned, so the sunlight can reach gardens 1, 2, 3 and 5.

Lars Kaj has previously denied this, since the trees possibly are also covered by the preservation of Lyngby lake. It has been suggested that raised planting beds be built in gardens 4 and 6 to compensate for the infertile soil. A vote will be held for financial support for the raised flower beds. Proposed by Amanda A21.

f. Requirements of employee contracts and confidentiality agreements for the Netork Group's members.

To ensure that members of the network group do not put the dorm in a bad position because of lack of documented systems, personal information being misused, etc. we wish to be contracted and we wish to sign a confidentiality agreement.

We could knowingly switch equipment so that illegal actions couldn't be traced with certainty, or in other ways counteract K-Net's (and the dorm's) responsibility of logging. Other (extreme) cases could be that we released the names of everyone with unlisted addresses or sold e-mails to spammers.

We do not feel that it is our responsibility to formulate these documents, and would like the residents' council to take care of it – with help from the KAB law department. We look forward to reading a draft of these documents. As soon as possible. Proposed by the Network Group.

g. Orientation regarding structural changes to the mailing lists at nybro.dk (also a presentation of guidelines for alle_beboere@nybro.dk and a new collective mailing list called social@nybro.dk). Proposed by the Network Group. See appendix.

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Appendix 8g – Orientation regarding structural changes to the mailing lists at nybro.dk**Orientation:**

In order to accommodate the structural changes to the mailing lists at nybro.dk, the Network Group has decided to deactivate all mailing lists other than “alle_beboere”. In accordance with the wishes of several chairmen, a collective mailing list with the name “social” will be established, which can then be used by chairman of all the dorm's clubs. Both will follow clear usage guidelines.

Motivation:

We have discovered, through the many false e-mail addresses, that many regard any correspondence from a @nybro-mailing list as “buy/sell spam”. Many have not differentiated between e.g. “meddelelse”, “kc_reklame” and “alle_beboere”, but have just deleted all e-mails.

This is a problem since the mandatory e-mails do not reach all of the recipients. We would like to define clear boundaries between primary, secondary and tertiary information to the dorm's residents, so all residents can freely choose which level of information they wish to receive.

Usage guidelines:

alle_beboere@nybro.dk

Can be used by the janitor, the Network Group, the Secretariat, the residents' council chairman and the Complaints Committee.

E-mails must be sent in both Danish and English.

The mailing list is used to send mandatory and/or very important information (such as the budget, and shutting off the hot water).

The mailing list can also be used to send information regarding long-term network down time (≥ 1 day, caused by cut cables, malfunctions at Nybrogård, K-Net, UNI-C), general instructions regarding behavior (such as stricter rules regarding noise during exam periods), faulty plumbing installations.

When sending an e-mail, the relevance for all residents should be thoroughly considered.

social@nybro.dk

Can be used by club chairmen and the janitor.

Replaces such lists as “kc_reklame”, “nybrofestival” and advisements from the janitor (such as lighting of the Christmas tree).

The e-mails should be directed at a large part of the dorm's residents' interests (KælderCaféen, festival, lighting of the Christmas tree, Green Dormitory)

The e-mails should be sent in both Danish and English.

The intention is that all information will be passed on nybro.dk/forum or through relevant pages under nybro.dk (the news or clubs pages). This includes minutes of residents' council meetings, which can be presented in a so-called ‘sticky thread’ on the forum (always placed at the top).

No changes will be made to the internal mailing lists, since these only reach people who actively joined a club/committee.

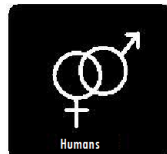

Food and drink of Easter

During Easter in Denmark, Easter lunches with lots of good food are traditionally held. The Easter lunch is traditional in the same way as the Christmas lunch, which means there are many things that 'should' be served at an Easter lunch.

Beer, especially the Easter brew, which is sold in the weeks preceding Easter, is typically served at the Easter lunch.

During Easter, a lot of chocolate is served – both as Easter eggs, as raw chocolate, marzipan eggs, chocolate baskets and many other varieties.

Food at the Easter lunch

At the traditional Easter lunch, three dishes are typically served. Usually starting with fish:

- Herring (curried, marinated, fried, spiced, and so on)
- Eggs (hard boiled)
- Shrimp

- Tuna

• Cold cuts, liver paté, and so on
After this comes a heated dish, which can consist of just about anything. Traditionally, it contains lamb, eggs or chicken.

The third dish is typically a cheese buffet with grapes, red bell peppers and crackers.

Easter eggs

During Easter, a lot of chocolate is traditionally eaten – and not less so because many Easter eggs are made of chocolate. Easter rabbits and Easter bunnies are also sold as chocolates.

Chocolate Easter eggs are often used as the gift that is given when the person to whom you have sent a gækkebrev (a letter with the sender's name hidden in a riddle) guesses that you sent it. The Easter egg can of course be made of some-

thing other than chocolate, which it often was in old times.

Many chocolate factories and stores produce beautifully shaped and decorated Easter eggs before the holiday. There are often competitions revolving around producing the largest chocolate Easter egg.

The world's largest Easter egg

The Belgian town Sint Niklaas currently holds the world record for the largest Easter egg, and is recorded in Guinness Book of World Records. The Easter egg consists of 50,000 chocolate bars, and is made by the Belgian chocolate manufacturer Guylian. The egg is 8.32 meters tall, and is made of a total of 1,950kg of chocolate.
