And no less, goodbye to Nybrogård Kollegiet.

But to make sure my goodbye does not mean a goodbye to NybroTidende, I would like to hear from you if you are interested in taking over the job as editor of the paper – or becoming part of an editorial team.

Please send an application with a description of yourself and why you would like to be editor or part of an editorial team. The application should be sent to tidende@nybro.dk July 1st, at the latest. Interviews will follow.

What does the job entail?

The job as editor is both challenging and rewarding. You will have the opportunity of engagin in your passion for writing, and will at the same time receive an insight in the lives of the other residents' lives through the articles.

I have through my four years as editor been far and wide. I have joined the Blue Men for a day of their work, I have covered football matches and participated in Garden Group days. I have learned about beer brewing and kayaking, as well as overhearing festival meetings and other events that may interest you as a resident. Last but not least, I have met many sweet, enterprising, accommodating people that each had their own story to tell.

Here are some facts about the job as editor:

- You will be employed by the residents' council and payed DKK 120 per hour.

- You control your working hours from month to month – it should be expected to use between 20 and 30 hours each month.
- It is up to you (and, if applicable, other editorial staff) to decide which articles have value for the other residents. The minutes from the last residents' council meeting and notice of the next are always required.
- The paper is published each month, except January, July and August – and the paper should be published no less than four days before the next residents' council meeting.
- It is up to you, though often in cooperation with the residents' council chairman, to hire translators, journalists, photographers, graphic designers and other help for the paper if necessary. A proper hiring procedure should be followed before hiring anyone, so everyone interested has the opportunity to apply.
- You will receive access to a printer where you can print NybroTidende in color. These copies must be passed out, so that each kitchen receives two, each apartment receives one, besides Lars Kaj, who receives one, two for the laundromat and three for the kiosk. Around 150 copies total.
- NybroTidende is published in both Danish and English. Currently, there are two translators associated, Nikolaj N16, and Edward O50. You can freely decide if you want to create a single joined edition or separate Danish and English editions, which is the case at the moment.

If you have any questions, you are very welcome to write.

Minutes of Residents' council meeting Monday May 7th 2012

At 19 in the GH-basement

Present: Nina C23, Jonas D59, Thomas C22, Jakob G02, Amanda E22, Celina G02, Hallur L10, Torbjørn O63, Simon A26, Cecilie D05, Camilla L01, Anna M45, Christian M61, Gitte P15, Majbritt S05, Samuel D46

Cancellations: Mikkel J21, Lars Kaj

Ad 1) Jonas D59 has been elected moderator, and English is the chosen language for the meeting.

Ad 2) 10 voting members are present.

Ad 3) The minutes of the last residents' council meeting are approved.

Correction to topic 5: There have been paid salaries of about DKK 6,800, DKK 12,500 for FC Nybro girls and boys and about DKK 21,000 of the DKK 60,000 for new canoes and kayaks. The rest is just budgeted, but not paid out.

Correction to topic 6: There has been applied for DKK 5,000 for the active party. This is unanimously approved and the funds can be paid out.

Ad 4) The agenda is approved.

Topic 8A cannot be voted on in the residents' council meeting, as it must be taken up at the residents' meeting first.

Ad 5) Economy:

The is DKK 130,000 on the NYK account and DKK 400,000 on the network account.

Currently the money on the network account are not being used, but there has been mentioned that they could be spent on paying off loans. There have been paid about DKK 5,500 in salaries, DKK 30,000 for the new canoes and kayaks, DKK 17,000 for kayak racks and DKK 5,000 for the active party. Furthermore, there has been a profit of about DKK 8,000.

Ad 6) Other news

There has been the active party where there was spent DKK 4,201.65 on food. The grill which was used, was bought at a very low price and can be used henceforth on other arrangements. There has been consumed alcohol for DKK 5,701.53. It was a very good arrangement, however there were some actives who

were not invited, which is not acceptable and must be improved on for next year.

Ad 7) Board meeting

There has been a board meeting on 26.04.12.

DKK 100,000 has been granted for renovation on the floor in KælderCaféen.

The budget has been reviewed and the rent will not rise after all. A reviewed budget will be provided at a later date.

Two of the dorm loans have been re-organized as it was worth the effort.

It was discussed whether the dorm should start accepting motivated applications from new tenants. No conclusion had been reached, as there were divided opinions.

It was also discussed whether the dorm representatives in the board should be paid. It is now up to Andreas and Camilla to decide this.

There has been a verdict concerning heat and electricity from 2012, and this will not be changed. Apartments are no longer to be part of the heating budget.

The dorm is now part of the EMO scheme, which is an energy label legal requirement. This will inform about the energy that is being used in the leases.

At the moment the waiting periods are 5 months for rooms and 2 years for apartments.

The next meeting is 11.11.12.

Ad 8A) Modification of CopyDan-fee

It has been suggested that since the apartments no longer have to pay for heat and electricity for the common kitchens, the CopyDan-fee should not be distributed evenly among tenants, but instead should be charged per kitchen, as is the original idea.

This cannot be decided upon now, as is it must be discussed in the residents' meeting and hereafter in the board.

This will be discussed in the next residents' council meeting where there will be more information and figures on this.

Ad 8B) Proposition of the budget of KælderCaféen

See appendix sent along with the notice. There have for 1 quarter been expenses of DKK 68,460.26 and income of DKK 75,719.49, granting a surplus of DKK 7,259.22.

Ad 8C) Slot machines at Nybro Kiosk

Ahmed is applying for the option of having slot machines in his business to increase revenue. There is being applied for a written permission.

Will be discussed in the board. There does not seem to be much interest from the dorm residents.

Ad 8D) Renovation – what was forgotten

When they in 2010 ended a DKK 23 million renovation of the dorm, they forgot to renovate the rooms that are not used for residency. Therefore there is being applied for the residents' council to utilize their DKK 40,000 maintenance budget for completing the renovation. The DKK 40,000 are available because of the antenna. This will be done over a number of years. Such as many of the outlets in the basements are not grounded. This will be discussed in the board and may be written into the long term budget instead.

It was also suggested that the funds could be spent otherwise, such as a new floor cleaning machine for the cleaning staff, or renovation of the bike sheds. As Mikkel J21, who proposed this, was not present the discussion has been postponed.

Ad 8E) Noise and other nuisances by KælderCaféen during exam periods

KælderCaféen should limit their opening hours, as a minimum during DTU exam periods in May and December.

Nobody from JK-odd has shown up, therefore it is difficult to make decisions about this.

If DTU exam periods are of concern then everybody's exam periods are of concern. Furthermore it is very few who have exams on Saturdays. If KælderCaféen is shut down the parties will most likely take place in the

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kitchens instead, and thereby be even more disturbing for dorm residents. However it might be acceptable to give JK-odd a break during the exam periods as it is a great nuisance for those who live there.

If KælderCaféen is closed at 00.30 revenue will be lost and the same applies if it is shut down completely. DKK 27,000 will be lost at complete shut down and DKK 14,000-15,000 will be lost by closing at 00.30. KælderCaféen will therefore not keep open until 00.30 (sic). It has been suggested that the DKK 40,000 from the antenna could be used to buy more isolated window panes for JK-odd.

There was a vote to decide whether KælderCaféen should be shut down during the exam period.

In favour: 1
Opposed: 7
Abstain: 2

KælderCaféen will keep open during the entire exam period.

Ad 8F) Proposition of budget and application of deficit guarantee for Nybrofestival 2012.

See appendix sent along with the notice. Tickets can be sold at a discount price, as the festival is held over two days. The balance is at DKK -2,000. KælderCaféen is hosting the bar, as it did last year. More volunteers are required and these could be paid (with ticket, food, drinks card, etc.).

There was a vote to decide whether a deficit guarantee of DKK 40,000 should be provided for the Nybrofestival 2012.

In favour: 7
Opposed: 0
Abstain: 3

A deficit guarantee of DKK 40,000 will be provided.

Ad 8G) Phasing out of telephone grid

As the use of the land line telephones is minimal, it is suggested that it be shut down. It will still be possible to call internally but not externally whether in or out. Important people (key bearers, secretariat, complaint comitee, KælderCafé etc.) can either have a work telephone (cell) or be compensated for use of their own cell phone. Currently the system costs DKK 80,000 a year and it is estimated that the price can be reduced to about

DKK 20,000 a year with this solution. So a total save of DKK 60,000 a year which will reduce the rent. The DKK 20,000 for the internal solution is that there will still be an internal network and certain posts which must have telephones (sic).

There was a vote to decide whether to shut down the telephone grid.

In favour: 8
Opposed: 0
Abstain: 2

The telephone grid will be shut down.

Ad 9) New members and alternates

Mikkel J21 is resigning as alternate for JK-odd and Mikkel K43 is the new representative.

Ad 10) Other news

A new system for topics for the residents' council meeting is under way.

There will be a page on www.nybro.dk where there is form to be filled instead of sending the topics directly to the secretary. There will be sent a mail about this when the system is ready. For now all topics must still be submitted to the secretary.

Mikkel J21 is resigning as key person, and another one is needed. This will be a topic for the next residents' council meeting.

Ad 11) Next residnets' council meeting is on Tuesday June 5th at 19.00 in GH-basement.

Topics for the agenda must be submitted to Nina C23, nina_sig@hotmail.com, **no later than 10 days early.**

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
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F.C. Nybro Chicks in action against Egmont's girls

FC Nybro on a winning streak

Sunday June 3rd FC Nybro played the final league match of the spring. Here you can read what assistant coach Jakob, C3, has to tell about the match and status of the team before the summer break.

The spring season has gone really well. We have seen many new faces on the team, and we have come a long way, both score-wise but also socially. The social environment in and around the team has risen again for this season, and by average we have seen greater participation for practice than last year. Routine-wise we had an unlucky start in the league, where we against the William Demant-dorm finished with a tie 1-1 after having led the entire match and definitely being the better team. After this, there have been victories against Tietgen, Hjortespring og Nordisk, until we last Sunday in a true match were rather unlucky with ending with a tie against the Rigshospitalet dorm (RHK). This has ensured the continuous tension in the top of the row.

For the match last Sunday we stood with a relatively weak team, considering that the opposing team had first place, and had defeated William Demant 9-1. Though we did have a good start and fought our way. After 25 minutes we take the lead with a goal scored by Ole Busborg Jensen. This position was kept for then, and when it was time to take a break, it was most welcome.

The second half started with a penalty after 15 minutes. There was no doubt about the foul, but since the tackle started outside the box, a free kick may have been a more appropriate call. Still, Knut Mathias Jensen approached the goal to take the penalty. The shot was placed in the upper left corner, bringing us in front 2-0. Things were really looking good now. Five minutes later, we found ourselves close to moving further ahead. We were in a 2 against 2 in a break situation. Knut was told to go it alone and take on his defender. With a quick dribble, he got by and was free to shoot at goal. The defense then chose to pull the handbreak, cynically and unsportsmanlike, the defender cut Knut down without the

least focus on the ball. Being the last defender, the illegal tackle should have resulted in a red card. The referees let him go with a yellow card, so the opposition would only be short of players for 10 minutes.

These ten minutes would prove to be bad for us. RHK scored two goals, of which the last was especially regrettable. Both were nonetheless nicely executed by the opposition's offense. With only 10 minutes left, both sides aggressively pursued a victory and resulted in chances at each end of the field. With three minutes left, the opposition's defense again chose to cut down Knut – this time, right in front of their goal. Christian Rubio was appointed the duty of taking the free kick, and he did it well. He curved the ball around the wall, towards the lower corner of the goal, where he scored. 3-2. We only needed

to keep the lead for two minutes to win, but we couldn't do it. With 10 seconds left, the opposition fired a lazy shot, which however had the perfect direction, precise to the millimeter, towards the bottom corner. Jonas almost had his fingers on the ball, but not quite. The ball went in, and we lost a step in the fight for the top, just when we were getting ready for a party.

All in all, the result was acceptable, but it was very regrettable having to throw away two points in the dying seconds, when we were as close as we could possibly get.

That leaves the cup quarterfinal match away against Hjortespring Friday June 15th at 18:00.



NybroTidende food column: Enjoy the food!



About me:

My name is Nanna D. Thomsen, I study nutrition and health and have resided in the dorm for about a year. Recently I took over the position as chairman of the garden group.

Furthermore I have a passion for food and raw goods from nature. From this passion comes the idea for this column.

Hope you will enjoy this column.

Recently I finished an amazing dinner club with dessert. This dessert has inspired this food column.

The recipe is a rhubarb trifle with rhubarb from my own garden – this is an option when you are part of the dorm garden group.

The recipe is as follows:

200 g. fresh rhubarb
Sugar
Vanilla pods
½ l whipping cream
200 g. breadcrumbs
Lemon balm for decoration

Boil the rhubarb with a little water and sugar, until the taste suits you, then for an additional 20 min. Fry breadcrumbs with sugar on a pan, take it off the heat and stir until it has cooled. Whip the cream. Place mush, breadcrumbs and whipped cream in layers, so you start with the mush and finish with the whipped cream.


Decorate with lemon balm and remember to invite your fellow dorm residents for dessert.

TIP: the rhubarb can of course be replaced with another substance, such as apple or raspberry, depending on season and contents of fridge and freezer.
