Information regarding the utilities report for 2011

[Excerpt from an e-mail from KAB]

A number of residents have complained about the distribution of utilities expenses for 2012. The case has been considered in the rent assessment committee of Gladsaxe municipality.

The rent assessment committee has approved Nybrogård Kollegiet's utilities report for 2010. No grounds for overriding the reports were found, neither because of errors in the material nor because of formalities. The report for 2010 will therefore not be changed. It is recommended that the distribution of expenses is considered changed.

It is further recommended that only residents with access to the common kitchens are included in the distribution of utilities expenses. This means that the 2-room apartments with standalone kitchens are no longer included in the distribution. The committee wishes to inform regarding the basis of distribution for expenses re-

lated to the common kitchens.

The utilities expenses from common kitchens will be evenly distributed among the 26 rooms of the respective hallway in this manner:

$$\frac{\text{Yearly utilities reading}}{26} \times \text{weight} = \text{share of utilities expenses in the common kitchen}$$

2-room apartments are not included in the distribution

The readings are continuous, so that the yearly reading is subtracted from the previously settled readings. The weight of the readings are calculated from each heating device's effect and heat transfer ability.

Other changes since last year:

A heat loss assessment has been conducted to compensate some rooms with a deduction in expenses. This is done to compensate for the extra expenses assumed through heating of outer walls and walls with non-heated adjacencies. The size of the deduction is shown on the heating assessment under item 3 with the text 'Fradrag for udsat beliggenhed'.

Minutes of residents' meeting Wednesday, April 11th, 2012

19:00 in the GH-basement

17 residents present at the meeting.

Re 1) Jonas is chosen as moderator and Danish is chosen as the language for the meeting. The agenda is approved.

Re 2) Presentation of the residents' council account of the last year

In the last year, Nybro Running has been created, a new football coach has been found and FC Nybro's girls team has been established. The Brewer's Club received DKK 1,800, the service lift to KældersCaféen has been replaced instead of repaired. The Canoe Club has received DKK 69,000 for new canoes, kayaks and other equipment. KældersCaféen has produced a positive financial report, a cake committee has been formed and the first cake festival has been held with great success. A logo competition has been issued, a vote for new TV channels has been started and a committee has been formed to look through the statutes and the order of business and make changes. Lastly, DTU has hosted an open house event which we, in the future, will be better to organize.

Re 3) Presentation of the institution's financial report of the last year

for approval. See appendix.

The report is not up for approval, only presentation.

Under fixed expenses, there are two large increases: fixed expenses has increased by DKK 200,000 which is spent towards ½ extra worker with the blue men. Staff has been cut back during the winter. Administration has increased by DKK 150,000, which is a very large increase compared to other years, which warrants a much desired explanation. Because of these increases, the rent will need to be increased by DKK 300,000, or DKK 17.49 per. The new average rent from 01.08.2012 for rooms will be DKK 1,688 and DKK 3,585 for apartments.

The membership fee for K-Net can not be DKK 80,000 since DKK 14,50 is paid each. A loan 'payments for loan regarding expansion of network' of DKK 24,000 is also being paid off.

There may have been overestimations in the budget, which could lead to a rent increase. An explanation for this is needed.

Insurances and administrative personnel has increased. An explanation is needed since only DKK 9,000 have been spent.

Re 4) Other

A proposal to impose motivated applications to the dorm has been made. This is to counteract the many residents moving out, and gain more active residents. Experience from other dorms show that at dorms with motivated applications, people stay longer because they have had to work to get in to the dorm. This is because of the 4-5 month waiting list to move in, which will increase during the summer.

This may keep many people from moving in, and the dorm is not located very centrally. People generally do not stay, so we may risk people choosing other dorms resulting in the residents only being people from DTU who see a longer future at the dorm. Motivated applications require more administration which raises expenses even more. We may also risk too many empty rooms and suffer rent losses. Moving in and out so often wears down the rooms along with the expenses involved. There is further talk about a maximum number of exchange students per hallway, since it wears on rooms and the social life of the hallway.

NYK's account holds DKK 163,000. Salaries of DKK 6,800 have been paid, DKK 12,500 paid to FC Nybro girls and boys. Around DKK 21,000 of the DKK 60,000 for the new canoes and kayaks have been paid. The rest is

budgetted but has not been paid yet.

DKK 4,000 has been spent on the athletics field towards a permit from the local authorities, which has since expired because the project died. Camilla L01 thinks about taking over the project at the start of the summer break.

Re 6) Other notices

Active Party will be held on May 5th, and DKK 5,000 have been proposed to cover the expenses. Unanimously approved. The money can be paid. The menu is roast suckling pig, so anyone who does not eat meat should contact Thomas C22.

The voting for new TV channels is under way. Since it is quite expensive to change channels, not all channels will be on election. A third cable package will be created, which will probably contain TV2 Sport.

The cake festival was a greater suc-

cess than expected with 53 cakes and 70 participants. The new chairperson is Ann-Louise N36.

Amanda withdraws as Garden Group chairperson and Nanna C25 is now appointed.

The Canoe Club have received new kayaks (they are still at the dealer's since a few things are missing) and canoes. All members of the Canoe Club will be deleted and they will then have to be registered with Ask again. An introductory course in kayaking will be held when the new ones arrive.

Ahmed needs money and seeks to be exempted of paying rent and also wishes help with the electric bill. This was turned down earlier, but will now be passed to the board. The questionnaire results about the kiosk and pizzeria will be given to Ahmed later.

Re 7) If applicable, minutes of last board meeting or agenda for the next

There is no news, since the meeting is not until April 26th. New staff has been hired; two in the complaints committee and 3 in the secretariat.

Re 8A) Hiring of staff for NybroTidende

Cecilie, D5, who is editor in chief of NybroTidende, has had several inquiries from people who wish to contribute to the paper with either the graphic setup or pictures. It should be discussed in the residents' council what the scope of a NybroTidende-team should be. It should also be discussed whether it is necessary with a formal hiring procedure when hiring new staff, or if the editor can choose freely whenever someone inquires.

Like the Network Group, NybroTidende functions independently under the residents' council. This can help secure the future operation of NybroTidende, since a group will be able to take over the work when Cecilie moves away from the dorm. An upper budget boundary may be proposed to limit the amount of hours spent on this. Proposal: An ad can be placed for the position. Proposal: over the summer break, a committee can be formed to find a new editor/team to run NybroTidende.

Re 8B) Recognition for internet upgrade

In connection with the internet upgrade at Nybrogård Kollegiet, Allan Boll has spent a large amount of time which, as it is now, he will not be compensated for, since the work has lain between K-Net and Nybro operations. The Network Group proposes that DKK 5,000 be awarded to Allan Boll as recognition and compensation for his work. The DKK 5,000 will be paid by the Network Group.

The DKK 5,000 will be registered as work-hours and it is unanimously approved.

Re 8C) Green Dormitory

Green Dormitory is looking for a new leader. The current leader, Amanda A21 is moving. Proposed by Amanda A21.

The next Green Dormitory is on May 27th, 2012. An ad for the position can be placed on the forum. It is a project manager position. If necessary, a

committee can be formed so a single person does not have the responsibility. Jakob C03, Nina C23 and Majbritt S05 will take over the project until further notice.

Re 8D) The garden group seeks approval to remove the blackberry bush by the CD-gardens.

The Garden Group proposes that the blackberry bush by the CD-apartments (but not by the canoes) be removed. This is due to the bushes spreading through the gardens. As it is now, the Garden Group's garden owners in the CD gardens have lost 25% of their gardens, and 3 gardens are completely overgrown. By removing the bushes permanently, this problem will be solved.

The blackberry bush will be removed, but excavators will be needed. This should probably be paid for by the buildings operations budget, but no money has been applied for, and a solution will be preferable. Nanna C25 will talk further with Lars Kaj concerning this to find a solution.

Re 8E) Problems with gardens 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in the LM gardens.

There are problems with these gardens because the soil is either infertile or so deeply shaded that plants have difficulty growing there. The gardens are protected by the preservation of Lyngby lake (Naturfredningnen af Lyngby sø), so the possibilities of improving these gardens are limited. Some trees, that were originally intended to be bushes can be pruned, so the sunlight can reach gardens 1, 2, 3 and 5. Lars Kaj has previously rejected this, since the trees possibly are also covered by the preservation of Lyngby lake. It has been suggested that raised planting beds be built in gardens 4 and 6 to compensate for the infertile soil. A vote will be held for financial support for the raised flower beds. The trees will be pruned as much as possible without killing them. Nanna C25 will talk with Lars Kaj about this. Regarding the infertile soil, raised planting beds can be built to compensate. Application for funds can be placed later.

Re 8F) Requirements of employee contracts and confidentiality agreements for the Network Group's members.

To ensure that members of the net-

work group do not put the dorm in a bad position because of lack of documented systems, personal information being misused, etc. we wish to be contracted and we wish to sign a confidentiality agreement.

This will be sent along to KAB's legal department, who will take care of it. Andreas D52 and Ask M47 will make sure it gets to KAB.

Re 8G) Orientation regarding structural changes to the mailing lists at nybro.dk

This should probably be rephrased to indicate a vote instead of an orientation, since the Network Group can not make this decision without the residents' council.

Everyone can unsubscribe to the mailing lists (except alle_beboere), so the argument for changing this is not necessarily sound. A small study has been made on the forum about how many people read the e-mails that are sent out. The result was around 25%. A new e-mail system should be set up, so only the important announcements are sent out by e-mail, and everything else is placed on the forum. This can be considered at the next meeting. Suggestions regarding how this might work can be sent to the Network Group.

Re 8H) The festival group seeks approval to host Nybrofestival over two consecutive days, the 21st and 22nd of September.

This shows success in other places, and there are no additional expenses involved with spanning two days, since the tent and such has already been rented. KælderCaféen can open both days so the party can be moved down there to contain it later on in the night.

For 12, against 0, blank 1. Proposal approved.

Re 8I) The festival group seeks deficit insurance of DKK 40,000

Last year's deficit was DKK 14,000, and by spanning the festival over two days, this might be halved. Usually a budget is presented when seeking deficit insurance. The DKK 40,000 will be used to invest before the festival and will come in again through ticket sales. A budget is needed before the deficit insurance can be approved.

Re 9) If applicable, election of new members and alternates, as well as information regarding members that are leaving the residents' council.

Amanda A21 withdraws from the residents' council.

Re 10) Other

Soda will be purchased for the residents' council meetings. Around 10 cases for DKK 700.

Items for the agenda should be more clearly phrased so long discussions

about matters besides the points are avoided.

A committee is formed to take care of the settling of utilities bills. It was the intention that the committee would consist of two room-residents and two apartment-residents. So far, the committee consists of Mikkel J21 and Majbritt S05, but two more are needed for this committee. Mikkel and Majbritt will make sure two more are found and proceed with the project.

The DKK 40,000 received from the

mobile antenna can be used for renovating basement facilities. Mikkel J21 will bring this to the board.





FC Nybro & FC Nybro Chicks ready for action

Spring has certainly come to Lyngby when the dorm's football team gather for another season on the turf. And this year, it is with two teams in the dorm tournament, that Nybrogård Kollegiet get ready to play at DTU's fields.

Both teams have now started their training and again this year, there is great support from the football interested residents. The boys have so far been visited by around 25 residents and gather at least 13 players at each practice since they started a month ago. 8) Incoming topics

a. Changing of CopyDan fee.

Since it has been decided that the apartments will not pay for heat and electricity for the common kitchens, I do not think it is reasonable that the CopyDan fee is distributed evenly among all residents, instead of being charged per kitchen, as it should be. Therefore I am drafting a vote

whether CopyDan fee should be distributed evenly or per kitchen. There will be voted about this. Proposed by Thomas C22.

b. Presenting the budget of KælderCaféen. See appendix.

c. Slot machines in Nybro Kiosk

Ahmed has an idea for increasing revenue for the kiosk, as it is doing poorly at the moment. He suggests that he could have slot machines in the store, to which he is applying for a written permission.

d. Renovation – what was forgotten

When they in 2010 ended a DKK 23 million renovation of the dorm, they forgot to renovate the rooms that are not used for residency. Therefore there is being applied for the residents' council to utilize their DKK 40,000 maintenance budget for completing the renovation. See appendix. Proposed by Mikkel J21.

e. Noise and other annoyances by KælderCaféen in exam periods

There is a desire for KælderCaféen to limit their opening hours, as a minimum in DTU exam periods in May and December. There will be voted about this. See appendix. Proposed by JK-odd.

f. Presentation of budget and applying for deficit guarantee for Nybrofestival 2012

The budget for Nybrofestival 2012 is based on last year's budget, but since

the festival spans over two days this year, the expenses are estimated to be greater. Because of this we are applying for a deficit guarantee for DKK 40,000, and this must be made available for advance payments. There will be voted about this. See appendix. Proposed by the festival committee.

g. Telephone central to be phased out

Since the use of land line telephony is minimal we suggest that it be dismantled. It will still be possible to call internally but not externally whether ingoing or outgoing. Important people (keyholders, secretariat, complaint committee, KælderCafé etc.) can either have a work telephone (cell phone) or be compensated for use of their own cell phone. Today the system costs around DKK 80,000 a year, and this could be narrowed down to DKK 20,000 a year, which would reduce the rent. There will be voted about this. Proposed by Mikkel J21 and Jonas D59.

Appendix 8d - Renovation, what was forgotten...

Proposed by Mikkel, J21

Synopsis:

When a DKK 23 million renovation was completed, the rooms not used for residency were overlooked. Therefore we are applying for the residents' council to spend its DKK 40,000 maintenance budget to complete the renovation.

Full text:

The residents' council has DKK 40,000 at its disposal from the dorm maintenance budget every year and currently have saved 2x DKK 40,000 for a multi course that unfortunately has not happened.

This means that in August the residents' council has DKK 120,000 available, which could be spent on maintenance issues in the dorm.

Therefore I propose the renovation of the rooms that were not included from the project back in 2009-2010.

This means the renovation of basement locales and depots (those near the stairwells) one block at a time, so that the dorm installations will only have grounded outlets. And lighting will be replaced by modern installations (such as LED lighting in depots and basement locales).

I am aware that DKK 80.000-120.000 is not much for something of this scale, but as long as we are not spending the money on other things, this might be a good plan.

Let me provide an example:

Maintenance year 2015-2016 the funds are not spent and the residents' council does not wish to reserve the funds for projects planned for 2016-2017. Therefore maintenance uses the DKK 40,000 for renovating the basement in PR, so all outlets are replaced and rewired. This will be executed during maintenance year 2016-2017.

This statement will also alert the board and maintenance to the problematic: that residents are not secured in the film club, bike refit shop or KælderCaféen etc. the same way as in their own rooms. And this can mean that more funds will be diverted to maintenance projects.

Finally I would like to point out that the DKK 40,000 are from the leasing of our chimney on the heating central for Telia cell phone mast and that it does not contribute to reducing our rent, but are sent to the maintenance needs of the residents' council.

Appendix 8e - Noise and other annoyances by KælderCaféen during exam periods

Topic up for voting

Proposed by JK-odd

Synopsis:

KælderCaféen should be have restricted opening hours, as a minimum during DTU exam periods in May and December.

Full text:

Since KælderCaféen is directly next to the JK-block, it is a severe annoyance that their guests are making a lot of noise during night hours, when they are getting some 'fresh air'. This usually happens in large groups and at a very high sound level.

KælderCaféen is already making an effort to limit this, but it is not enough during the periods when many of the dorm residents are preparing for their exams.

The rules today are that residents are not to make a lot of noise (have their own parties etc.), but KælderCaféen is allowed to be an annoyance for their neighbours in these periods, without the residents having the option of complaining, which gives a definitive and useful result. (sic)

Furthermore many of the late guests are a great nuisance when they are kicked out for closing time, as they often are very noisy en route to their rooms with no consideration for their neighbours. This means that residents are roused from their sleep because there is not a few drunk people now and then, but several large groups who therefore are more noisy.

By keeping closed, these annoyances are transferred from the neighbours to KælderCaféen, while a restriction means that the neighbours at least can enjoy another 2-3 hours of sleep in these busy periods.

By this happening during DTU exam periods we are affecting the greatest number of residents, where the number of other students are harder to consider more in this connection. (sic)

This is why JK-odd suggests to either keep closed or limit the opening hours during night hours, such as by closing at 00.30.

There is to be voted on whether KælderCaféen is encouraged by the residents' council to do one of the following:

Keep closed during DTU exam periods.

Or

Close at 00.30 on Fridays and no Saturday opening hours during DTU exam periods.



I will start with a classic dish from nature - stinging nettle soup. For 4 people you will need:

- 100 g. Stinging nettles
- 50 g. Ground elder
- 50 g. Ramson
- 1 Onion
- 5 Potatoes
- 1 Apple
- 1 litre of vegetable bouillon
- Salt
- Oil
- Lemon juice

Onions and potatoes are browned in a pot until the onions are clear.

Chop nettles, ground elder, ramson and apple and boil it together with bouillon and water.

Let the soup boil for about 30 minutes and taste with lemon and salt.

In this recipe it is important to add to taste with what you have, and thereby make the soup unique.


Dear residents of Nybrogård Kollegiet
