## Summary of Residents' Council Meeting Tuesday the 5th of June 2012

**Present:** Nina C23, Jonas D59, Thea D43, Thomas C22, Samuel D46, Torbjørn O63, Samuel D46, Mikkel J21, Mikkel K43, Alexander G28, Anna M45, Qi M41, Jakob C03, Trine C03, Cecilie D05, Mikkel R61, Hilbert P23, Ask M47, Camilla L01, Majbritt S05, Maria J34, Jesper C38 and Hallur L10.

**Cancellations:** Lars Kaj.

**Ad 1)** Mikkel J21 is chosen as moderator and English is chosen as language for the meeting.

**Ad 2)** 12 eligible voters are present.

**Ad 3)** The summary from the previous Residents' Meeting have been approved.

Correction to item 9: Mikkel J21 will be resigning from the Residents' Council on the 8th of June.

**Ad 4)** The agenda has been approved.

**Ad 5) Economy:**

There are currently 136.000 kr. on the NYK account and 417.000 kr. on the network account. 5800 kr. have been paid to KælderCaféen in order to cover the expenses for drinks to "active party", 12.000 kr. have been paid to the men's team of FC Nybro in order to cover the referee-expenses and so forth., and salaries have been paid in the amount of 5.200 kr. Mikkel J21 is still responsible for paying out the loan of Network Group. Sodas have been purchased for the Residents' Council in the amount of 2254,31 kr., which are to be paid out to Mikkel J21 who covered the expenses. This item is to be discussed when the need to buy sodas arises again in order to establish the proper procedure regarding what brands are to be bought, due to the fact that discounts are obtainable depending on the brands - and in order to find out who are to benefit from these discounts.

**Ad 6)** Misc. messages Two residents have been banned from the Canoe Club due to the fact that they hadn't brought life jackets with them, while they were out rowing.

**Ad 7)** Board Meeting

There hasn't been a board meeting and there is nothing new to add to the agenda.

Correspondence by mail has taken place concerning the requests that Ahmed have presented to the Residents' Council. The Board has decided not to pay his rent or his electricity bill, but he may put up gaming consoles in the Kiosk, if he wants to do so.

**Ad 8A) New Key Person**

Samuel D46, Mikkel R61, Alexander G28 and Hilbert P23 are all running for the position of new Key Person at Nybrogård Kollegiet.

Hilbert P23: He is studying at DTU and expects to remain a resident for at least another three years.

Samuel D46: He is studying at DTU and is a bartender and cashier at KælderCaféen. He expects to remain a resident for at least another two years.

Alexander G28: He has just graduated from HF and has six years of studying ahead of him, which means he'll stay here for a long time.

Mikkel R61: He is studying physics at KU and expects to remain a resident for at least another three years.

There has been a vote in order to decide who is to become the new Key Person.

Samuel D46: 3, Alexander G28: 4, Mikkel R61: 3, Hilbert P23: 2.

Alexander G28 has been chosen as the new Key person if he is able to provide a clean criminal record. New notices will be posted as soon as possible.

**Ad 8B) Applying for 19.032 kr. to fund a new bridge**

The budget has been sent out along with the notice to the meeting. The bridge needs to be replaced, due to the fact that it is about collapse and that it is much too tall compared to the water level (the water level in the lake has dropped 15 cm compared the water level last year). It is also taken into account whether the water level may rise again to ensure that it won't become an issue later.

There has been a vote: For: 9, Against: 1, Blank: 2.

The proposal has been approved.

**Ad 8C) The Bicycle Workshop is applying for funds to buy a new compressor, bicycle mount standand accessories in the amount of 2244 kr.**

See the appendix that was sent along with the notice to the meeting for additional information regarding the specifics of what they need money for. Things quickly disappear from the workshop, which means that certain blocks show concern whether the newly bought items will disappear or not. Precautions are being made by not placing any newly acquired items in the workshop immediately.

There has been a vote: For: 11, Against: 0, Blank: 1.

The proposal has been approved.

**Ad 8D) Green Dormitory**

Green Dormitory wants to hold a single event which includes both cleaning up the bikes and the thrash on Sunday the 16th of September 2012.

The previously planned day for Green Dormitory has been cancelled, due to the fact that the board did not find that the notices were dropped in the mailboxes in time. It is statutory to inform about this event by putting notices in the mail boxes at least two weeks in advance prior to the event.

Nina C23 resigns from Green Dormitory.

There will be a vote in order to decide whether the Green Dormitory event is to be held on the 16th september 2012.

There has been a vote: For: 9, Against: 0, Blank: 3.

The proposal has been approved.

**Ad 8E) New playground**

An indicative vote is requested regarding whether 50.000 kr., 100.000 kr. or 150.000 kr. is to be spent on a new playground for the children at the dormitory.

An offer has been obtained at the price of 155.268 kr. It includes a swing, grass mats, a sandbox, a jungle gym with a slide and two

seesaws. The price can be downgraded compared to what is needed in order to lower the expenses. There is a ten-year warranty, but it will last at least 20-25 years.

There are three different suggestions regarding where to place the playground; two in the JK-yard and one in the EF-yard. It is e.g. possible to only use 50.000 kr. this year and then expand e.g. over a course of three years.

This item needs to be thought over concerning how much money that is needed for this compared to how many people that are going to use it, seeing that only a small fraction of the residents have children. There is also a problem with excessive noise when many children are gathered at one place. If the playground is to be placed in the JK-yard, there is a risk that drunk people from KælderCaféen might play at the playground during the night. The consensus is that it's quite a lot of money to spend compared to the fact that there aren't that many families with children. It is possible to apply for funding either with the help of foundations or the local authorities seeing that it is a lot of money to spend compared to the amount of people at the dormitory that are going to use it. The playground may also be placed juxtaposed with the kindergarten in order to move the noise moved further away. The playground may also be combined with a few stands that may be used for physical workout so that more people are able to enjoy the playground. It is also possible that the children may be able to use the playground at the kindergarten by talking to the local authorities. Alternatively, only two seesaws or a swing may be erected at a much lower cost. It has been proposed that another item subject to a vote concerning the playground is to be added to the agenda and thus continue to work on the playground, but at a lower price. Continue to work on the playground with funds below the amount of 20.000 kr. or lower: 7

The proposal is still being worked on, but at a price consisting of 20.000 kr. or lower.

**Ad 9)** New members and substitutes

Mikkel J21 resigns as substitute for JK-odd, and Mikkel K43 joins as a new representative.

Thea D43 is the new representative for NO-odd, and Thorbjørn is a substitute for NO-odd.

Cecilie D05 resigns.

Jakob C03 resigns.

**Ad 10) Misc.**

The NybroFestival is permitted to play music until 2 AM, but in order to prevent that the party continues in the hallways, it is requested that KælderCaféen is opened afterwards until 5 AM both on Friday and Saturday and refrain from using their monthly Saturday opening. NybroFestival is held from the 21st to 22nd of September 2012. This item will be addressed at a later time. Cecilie D05 will be moving out soon, and people who wish to take over NybroTidende are wanted. There will be an article about this in NybroTidende. The position may easily consist of several people and not just one person.

There are problems with the TV-signal. Offers have been obtained regarding day-to-day service, which will be able to help a lot faster when problems arise. Contact Lars Kaj for problems by mail.

The board of the change of rules of procedure and regulations for the Dormitory Association have suggested the following changes:

The Committee suggests a change in the rules of procedure for the Residents' Council at Nybrogård Kollegiet, § 3, stk. 2, so that a part 2 is added: § 3, stk. 2: Suggestions that are to be dealt with at a Residents' Council must be submitted along with motivation at least 10 days before the meeting takes place. The proposal will otherwise be discarded from the agenda. Proposals must be submitted to the secretary in the following manner: Title, an optional short summary,

motivation - optionally with elaborate annexes.

The Committee suggests changes in the Addenda for Regulations for the Dormitory Association NYK. It concerns the following changes for addendum 2: NybroTidende, and addendum 3: NetDrift.

Regarding Addendum 2, paragraph 2, 3, og 7: "and translators" is to be added after "journalists".

A part 2 is to be added to Addendum 3, paragraph 1 so that paragraph 1 henceforth reads: NetDrift is employed by the Residents' Council. NetDrift may in consultation with the chairman of the Residents' Council employ new staff in correlation with § 2, paragraph 9.



# F.C. Nybro is back on the field

The summer holidays are coming to an end for most of us, which not only means that the beginning of the semester is just around the corner - so is the autumn season for our dormitory's two soccer teams. We are able to muster - for the very first time ever - both a men's (M) and a ladies' (L) team in the dormitory tournament. Both teams have been making good results this spring, but more wants more.

If you are interested in joining either team, do note that both teams are always in the need of more players. You can sign up through Facebook (see the bottom of this article) or contact the coaches through Nybro.dk. Already now, both teams are training for the challenges beyond the autumn season.

The men's team are at an advantage in the battle for climbing the ranks, considering that placing second might just be enough to move up a rank through a playoff final. The scores are close, however, and the loss of merely one point may easily send Tietgen right past our men's team. The most important two games this seasons are most likely coming up this month, where they need to defeat the leading team from RHK the 13th of September, and then re-

peat the process ten days later against Tietgen as well. But If they manage to win these two games, the team would be ranking first, and then everything will be in their own hands. F.C. Nybro Chicks are already playing in the first division. Climbing the ranks isn't a priority to them, however; they're rather in it to obtain medals. With only three points up to second place and a game at hand, there's nothing to lose. They need to make distance to the other lower ranked teams both in the games against POP and Egmont. If they are victorious in both games, everything will be in place for an exciting match for medals the following month. Prior to this, however, both teams need to make way in the cup. The men's team play their first semi-finals against Tietgen the 9th of September, after which the ladies' team will get cracking with their quarter-finals against RHK right. Spectators are more than welcome. Both teams have their training sessions at the fields right across Engelsborgskolen: Go to the traffic lights that are nearby our local Netto, take a left, and then you'll soon find the fields to your immediate right. An offer regarding new dumbbells has been received from Fitnessgruppen in the amount 22.477,5 kr. (incl. value added tax) with this particular amount being sought from the Residents' Council. i. The two soccer teams of the dormitory seek funding in the amount of 3.183 kr. for misc. items which includes four new soccer balls for the men's team, a new ball pump, anti-inflammatory sprays and icebags for both teams. ## NybroTidende food column: Enjoy the food!



### About me:

My name is Nanna D. Thomsen, I study nutrition and health and have resided in the dorm for about a year. Recently I took over the position as chairman of the garden group.

Furthermore I have a passion for food and raw goods from nature. From this passion comes the idea for this column.

Hope you will enjoy this column.

We are currently experiencing one of the best seasons of Denmark. Other than the sun and high temperatures the summer also grants you the opportunity to collect and gather berries and fruits in the wild. These berries are at no charge, so it's advisable to take advantage of this for as long as you can. In this food-column I'll be bringing a recipe on rosehip-plum jam to you from "Den grønne Syltebog", considering that both rosehips and plums are ripe at the moment. The recipe is as follows:

375 grams of plums or cherry plums.

125 grams of whole rosehips or 85 grams of cleansed rosehips.

125 grams of sugar.

Roughly half a teaspoon of red melatin (vegetable thickener).

Optional: liquid Atamon (preservative).

Rinse the plums with water, cut them up and remove the stones. Separate the flowers and stems from the rosehip-fruits, and then rinse the fruits with water. Cut them up and remove the seeds; note that you can cut up the rosehips and plums in any size of your choice. It might be a good idea, however, to cut up the rosehips into smaller pieces than the plums due to the fact that the former aren't

boiled to a mash easily. Boil the fruits and all the sugar - excluding 2 tablespoons of sugar - together for about 5-10 minutes. Mix the melatin and the remaining sugar and sprinkle it gently over the fruits while stirring. Boil it all for 2 minutes and then pour it into jars. In order to make the jam last longer rinse the jars with liquid Atamon before you pour in the jam.

## The Dark Knight Rises

To those, who neither are familiar with The Dark Knight Rises or Christopher Nolan's films, I'd like to mention, as an introduction, that the movie is the final one in his Batman trilogy. The idea with getting Batman up on the silver screen is not new, however. Other Batman series have already been made starring the seasoned superhero, for instance with Tim Burton as director.

The movie more or less tells the story of multi-billionaire Bruce Wayne, who has become a recluse over the past 8 years, seeing that there is no longer any need for his alter ego, Batman, now that his city Gotham City, is in a state of peace. But peace doesn't last very long, and he must once again rise to the occasion and fight for the safety of his city: A man only known by the name of "Bane" is threatening to destroy Gotham City, and Batman will need all the help he can get. He has also gone soft over the past 8 years, and the question is, whether he is even able to defeat his new opponent.

It's hardly necessary to see the first two movies, but you'll have a better understanding of everything that happens if you already know them. That is usually the case for most sequels anyhow. The director did, however, do a nice job to ensure that no-one is left behind, no matter how little they may already know about the Batman universe or the previous movies.

The Dark Knight Rises is quite similar to Batman Begins for better and worse; both movies take a good while to get started, but the way it builds up makes sense anyway, due to the fact that it greatly adds to the excitement. A movie critic once said that a movie is only as good as its villain, which isn't entirely wrong either, and in the same way, the villain also plays a big part in defining the main theme of the movie.

In Batman Begins the main theme was fear and anxiety, which was partly due to his opponent's desire to spread fear and terror and also due to Batman's own phobia of bats, whereas everything was about random chaos and destruction in The Dark Knight. In

The Dark Knight Rises, Bane is trying to crush Batman physically, but especially mentally as well, and send both him and Gotham City into a state of false hope followed by despair. But it's not needed at all to make this kind of analysis to enjoy the movie; there are plenty of exciting action scenes that'll keep you on the edge of your seat.

In my opinion the movie is better than Batman Begins, but it is not better than The Dark Knight, due to the fact that it resembles the first movie in so many ways.

I give it 5 out of 6 stars.
